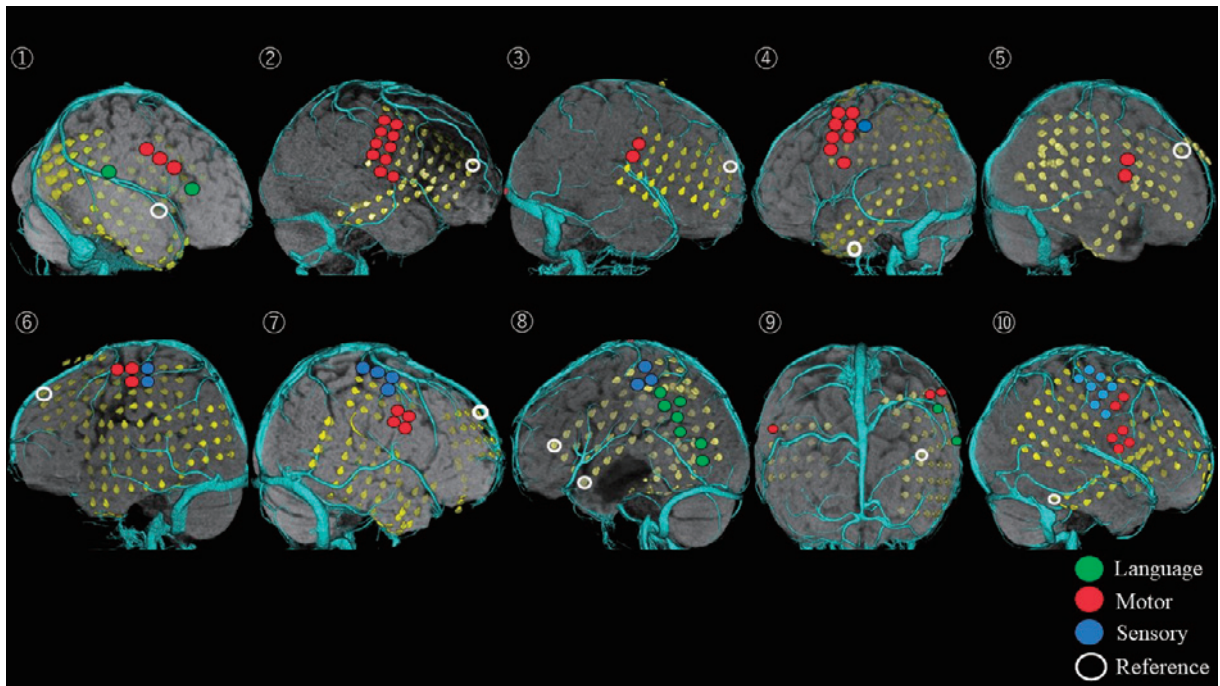


Fig. 1 The locations of electrodes and eloquent cortices in Pt. 1-10. The green, red and blue circles indicate the electrodes that elicited the language, motor and sensory symptoms in the monopolar functional mapping, respectively. The white circles indicate the reference electrodes in monopolar cortical stimulation.

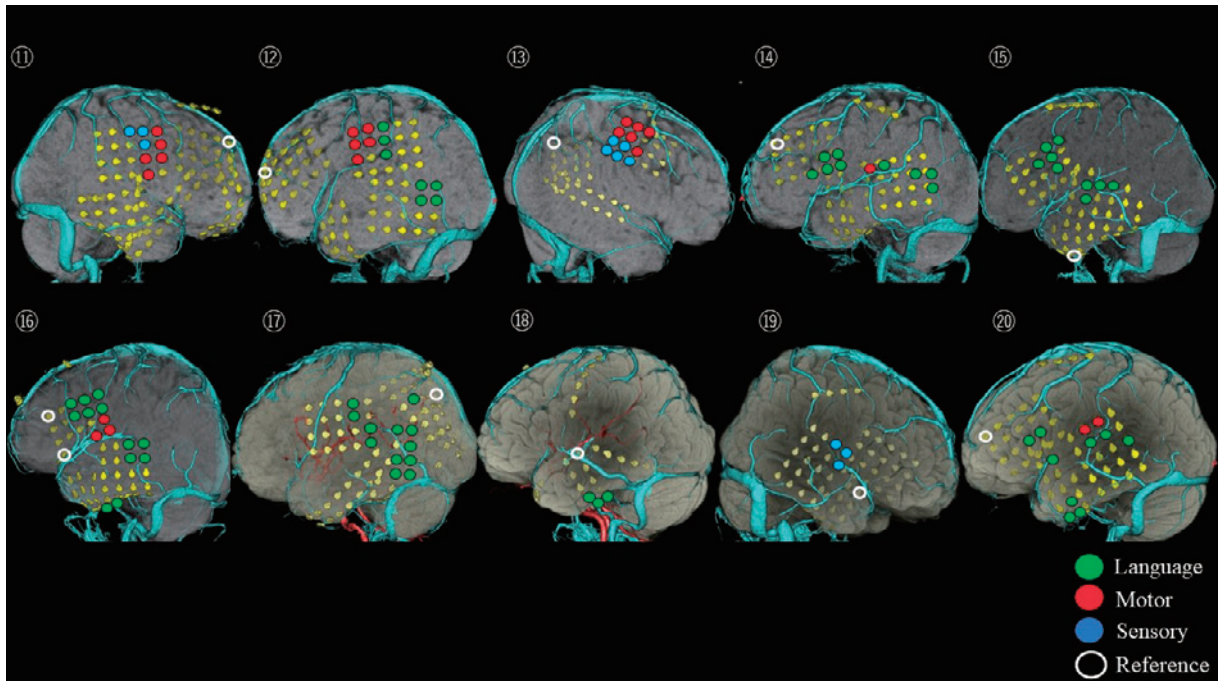


Fig. 2 The locations of electrodes and eloquent cortices in Pt. 11-20.
