Mortality and Causes of Death in Children With Cerebral Palsy With Scoliosis Treated With and Without Surgery

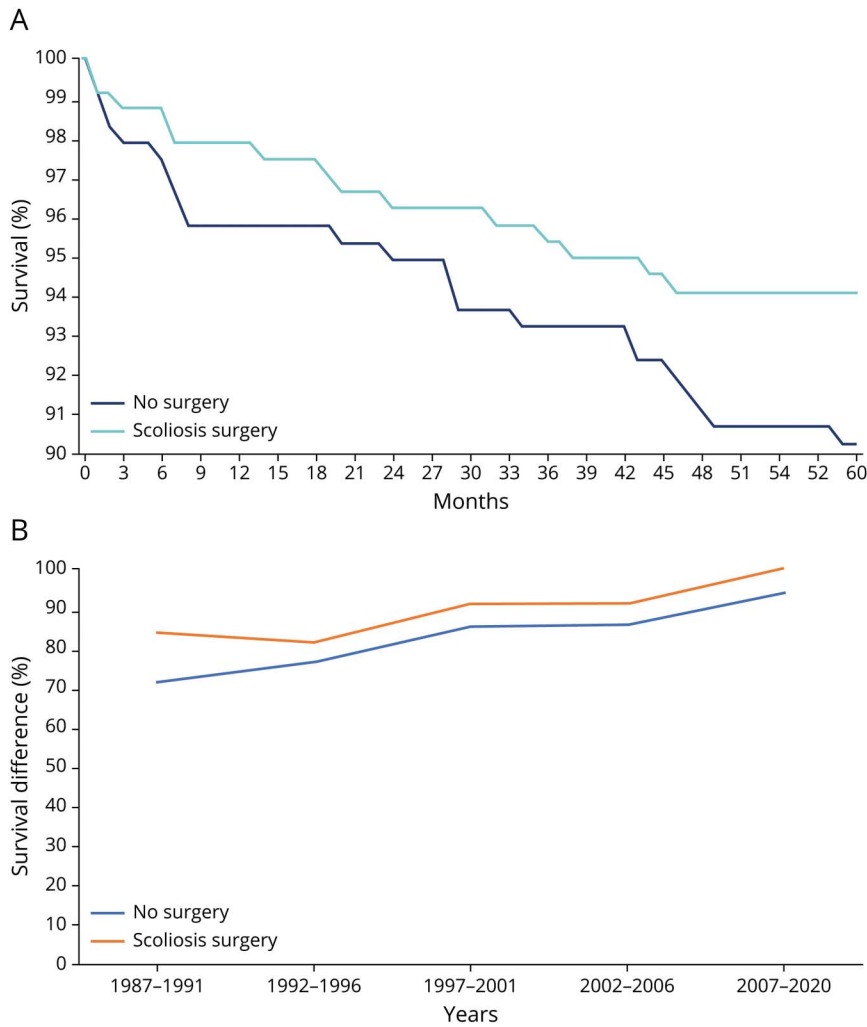

(A) Survival function showing the survival in months starting at the age of surgery (median 12.8, interquartile range 9.2–15.2) in surgically treated patients and at the age of diagnosis of scoliosis in nonsurgically treated patients ($p = 0.047$).
