Distribution of *Streptococcus suis* capsular types in 1999

From January to December 1999, 344 streptococcal isolates were received as *Streptococcus suis* in our laboratory for serotyping. They originated from veterinary diagnostic laboratories in Quebec, with smaller numbers from other Canadian provinces and the United States. Serotyping was carried out using the coagglutination test. The distribution of capsular types of the 344 isolates is given in Table 1.

In 1999, capsular type 2 represented 15% of all the isolates, which is the lowest prevalence of this serotype in the past decade; in 1990, the prevalence of this serotype was 32% (1). Capsular types 1/2 and 3 accounted for 13% and 10% of isolates, respectively, followed by capsular types 8 (7%) and 5 (6%). Five capsular types, 1, 4, 9, 21, and 23, each had a prevalence of 4%. The percentage of untypable isolates was of 11%. Most of the time, these isolates were not capsulated upon arrival or showed autoagglutination. In our opinion, there is no justification at the present time for the characterization of new capsular types.

Table 2 compares the distribution of the 6 most prevalent *S. suis* capsular types identified between 1992 and 1999. Except for capsular type 2, variations in the



prevalence of the serotypes identified during this period were minimal (2); this may indicate that the level of infection with *S. suis* is stable in the swine population sampled.
