

## Errata

There were several errors in “Linkage of Familial Breast Cancer to Chromosome 17q21 May Not Be Restricted to Early-Onset Disease,” by Margaritte et al., in the June 1992 issue of the *Journal* (50:1231–1234). On page 1232, both in column 1, line 21, and in column 2, line 17, “ $1-I(y,x)$ ” should have read “ $1-I(y,x)$  (one minus).” And on page 1232, column 2, line 24, “unaffected” should have read “affected.”

There were several errors in “Mutations of the *KIT* (Mast/Stem Cell Growth Factor Receptor) Proto-Oncogene Account for a Continuous Range of Phenotypes in Human Piebaldism,” by Spritz et al., in the November 1992 issue of the *Journal* (51:1058–1065). On
