The figure and the legend are therefore provided:

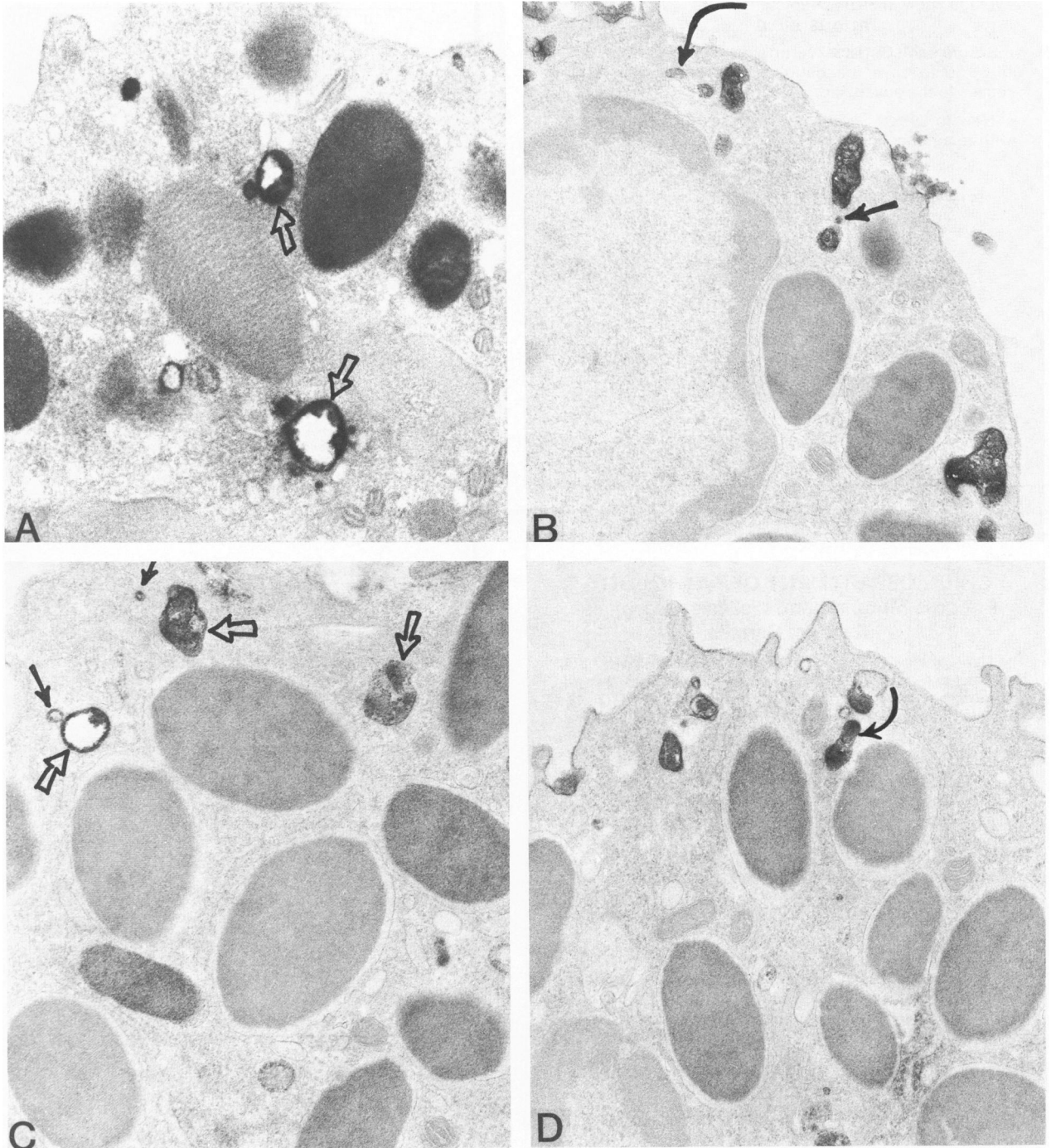


Figure 2—Guinea pig basophils reacted for peroxidase content after exposure to EPO for 15 minutes (A) or 30 minutes (B–D). Note positive cytoplasmic vesicles (solid arrows), vacuoles (open arrows), and tubules (curved arrows). In these cells, most of the granules are peroxidase-negative, but several are strongly positive (A). (A, $\times 25,000$; B, $\times 22,000$; C, $\times 27,500$; D, $\times 25,000$)
