
Selected list of books and journals in allied health*

This list of 410 books and 76 journals is intended as a selection guide to be used in a library supporting allied health educational programs or allied health personnel in either an academic or health care setting. Because of the impossibility of covering the large number and wide variety of allied health professions and occupations, the recommended publications are focused primarily on the educational programs listed and described in the AMA's *Allied Health and Rehabilitation Professions Education Directory*, plus physical therapy, dental allied health, medical secretarial, nutrition, and speech pathology/audiology programs. Books and journals are categorized by subject; the book list is followed by an author/editor index, and the subject list of journals by an alphabetical title listing. Items suggested for initial purchase (163 books and 31 journals) are indicated by asterisks. To purchase the entire collection of books and journals (1996 subscriptions) would require an expenditure of about \$26,740. The cost of only the asterisked items totals \$11,160.

For those who have not used our previous lists of recommended allied health publications for collection development purposes or who are not familiar with them, it might be worthwhile to review the concept of "allied health" and the parameters that we have used over the years to determine scope of subject coverage. We initially undertook this project in the fall of 1981 for the primary purpose of developing a selection guide for allied health publications because none existed and an ongoing need was being expressed by both academic and health sciences librarians. Developing collections of allied health literature was and still is a challenge. Even today, allied health literature is far more unfamiliar to most health

sciences librarians than is the literature of medicine, nursing, and dentistry. It is the literature of a large number of diverse health-related disciplines lumped together under the umbrella term of *allied health*. It is not the literature of *just one* discipline.

The first question we asked as we took on this project was, What is allied health? There seemed to be no consensus on a definition for the largest and most complex health profession constituency in the United States, which has an estimated membership ranging from three to ten million. To date, no one has come up with a universally acceptable definition. While sources differed on who should and who should not be included under the allied health umbrella, most did agree that autonomous health professionals such as chiropractors, dentists, nurses, optometrists, osteopaths, pharmacists, physicians, podiatrists, and veterinarians should not be designated as part of allied health. After these professions were eliminated from

our literature review, we still had more than 200 discrete health professions and occupations, ranging from health sciences librarian to physician assistant to orderly.

Since we were not exactly sure on our own how to choose the most significant programs and because we had to make this project feasible, we decided that our allied health book and journal list would predominantly support the educational programs accredited by the AMA Committee on Allied Health Education and Accreditation (CAHEA) that were listed and described in the *Allied Health Education Directory*; at that time there were twenty-six CAHEA accredited programs [1]. To those programs we added allied dental personnel (dental hygienist, dental assistant, and dental laboratory technician) and medical secretary, because librarians in community and junior colleges were actively trying to access material for these programs. After nearly three years of work, our first list of recommended allied health books and journals was published in October 1984 [2].

In the updates of our allied health list, we have based our choices for reviewing literature very heavily upon the programs that have appeared in the annual editions of the *Allied Health Education Directory* (now titled *Allied Health and Rehabilitation Professions Education Directory*, effective with the 1996-1997 edition). Shortly after we began the allied health list, physical therapy was no longer accredited by CAHEA, but instead by the American Physical Therapy Association. Since this is one of the fastest growing professions in the health care field, we obviously have continued to review physical therapy books and journals. In the third version of this list, we included a "Nutrition" category because we had many requests from librarians and faculty to do so. We also added "Speech Pathology/Audiology" to the list that was published in 1992, since it was one of the ten groups of allied health personnel studied by the congressionally mandated Institute of Medicine Committee to Study the Role of Allied Health Personnel; in our subject coverage we had previously included all of the other nine groups. It is interesting to note that this prestigious committee declared that there was little consensus as to which disciplines constituted allied health, and because the members felt that comprehensive definitions of allied health made the study of *all* allied health more difficult, they decided to forgo any attempt at a definition and focus their study on ten large, well-known allied health professions [3].

We have used the *Allied Health Education Directory 1995-1996* as our primary source for subject coverage in this allied health book and journal list, but it should be noted that the programs included are no longer accredited by the AMA. The AMA supported allied health education and accreditation for sixty years or

more. At a CAHEA meeting in October 1992, the AMA announced its intent to disband CAHEA and initially to support a new stand-alone agency to assume the accreditation responsibilities of CAHEA. In order to have a smooth transition, the AMA agreed to support CAHEA until July 1, 1994. The new agency, the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP), appeared in May 1994 and has been recognized by the Commission on Recognition of Postsecondary Accreditation (COPRA) [4]. During this transition period, the immediate questions were who would join CAAHEP and who would choose accreditation via professional organizations. Of the twenty-nine allied health programs accredited by CAHEA, only four professional associations sought independent recognition as accrediting agencies—clinical laboratory science, nuclear medicine, occupational therapy, and radiologic technology. All of the others joined the multidisciplinary CAAHEP. Fortunately, the AMA will continue to keep its Allied Health Education Database, which consists of information on more than 3,000 independently accredited programs and will continue its publication of the *Allied Health and Rehabilitation Professions Education Directory* on an annual basis.

While most health sciences librarians are aware of the turmoil that is occurring in medical education—specialist to generalist, problem-based learning, and evidence-based medicine are just a few of the recent changes and innovations—they seem to be less well informed about the even greater upheaval occurring in allied health. The AMA's relinquishing its role in accreditation of allied health programs has left the field without leadership. Some allied health educators believe these programs have been made even more vulnerable [5]. Others believe that because the accreditation process is too expensive and has needed revamping for a long time, the opportunity is now at hand to mold allied health programs to fit into the health care industry of the twenty-first century. To do this requires change, and for many people, including educators, change is scary. There is general agreement that allied health education accreditation, program by program, as it is carried out today, is not effectively achieving its goal and is astronomically expensive. Current accreditation is predominantly process-oriented while the U.S. health care system is fast becoming outcome-oriented [6]. The Pew Health Professions Commission, a program of the Pew Charitable Trusts, attempts to assist health professions schools to develop programs that are responsive to the health care needs of the public. It has been responsible for bringing into focus the importance of allied health personnel as the largest segment of the health care team. The commission believes that the present status of accreditation and licensure impedes change rather than encouraging it [7].

In addition to licensure and accreditation, there are two other forces challenging allied health education. The first is a move to establish schools or colleges of allied health as one entity—not as separate programs—and the second, the core curriculum. There are many reasons for advocating the formation of allied health schools: organized structure, increased visibility, interdisciplinary activities [8]. Even more important, they would provide the structure to enact *institutional* accreditation for allied health programs instead of accrediting each program separately. Program-by-program accreditation is largely uncoordinated, inefficient, and expensive [9].

While the values, skills, and competencies of health professions in general are being reexamined for higher quality, expanded access, and improved cost-effectiveness, educational programs are undergoing a comparable scrutiny, and this is especially true in allied health education. As a result, educational redefinition has renewed the focus on the core curriculum, a subject that was out of vogue during the highly specialized 1970s and 1980s. The core concept takes into account areas common to all health professions and might be considered as the basic general education for health care providers. The allied health core curriculum has been the subject of controversies; there has been disagreement regarding core curriculum size, content, and effectiveness. Its critics have been responsible for impeding core curriculum development.

Allied health educators are under pressure to train providers with competencies that are relevant to the present and future health care environments. Status quo is no longer acceptable, and the core curriculum offers the most viable route for effectively and financially cross-training employees to enter interdisciplinary health care delivery teams [10]. The Pew Health Professions Commission has published an in-depth report on core curriculum issues in allied health education; the contents of this report resulted from a two-day workshop held early in January 1995 [11]. The "sleeping giant," a name sometimes applied to the allied health professions, is in a state of flux, and its sleep is certainly being disturbed by the dramatic changes that are taking place in its accreditation, program autonomy, and core curriculum. How will these changes affect health sciences libraries and librarians? In most health science libraries, allied health literature still has an orphan status when compared with literature of the other health sciences professions. We hope that our efforts have helped to clarify the task of acquiring allied health literature.

As a rule, we have selected books and journals focused specifically on allied health, but if a medical text or journal is an integral part of the literature of an allied health discipline, it has been included. We have put an emphasis on current materials, predom-

inantly of U.S. origin, although some Canadian and a few British publications have been included. All the books that we have selected have been published since 1990 with the exception of one classic EEG text (1986–89). Only 3% of the books are dated prior to 1992; 72% are dated 1994 or later. We have chosen the most current books available because rapidly changing technology has a strong impact on many allied health professions and occupations. Because of our doing this, older books do not appear in this list, but they may have been included in earlier ones. We are aware that "new" does not necessarily mean "better." The *Journal of Allied Health* is an indispensable source for anyone associated with allied health from either a professional or an educational point of view.

A distinct literature for some allied health programs does not necessarily exist. For example, educational programs for the physician assistant rely heavily upon books in the basic and behavioral sciences as well as standard medical texts and journals, although a few physician assistant books are beginning to appear on the market. Medical publications can be identified from our list of recommended books and journals for the small medical library [12]. Programs for surgeon's assistant and surgical technologist are supported heavily by the literature of surgery and perioperative nursing; relevant nursing titles can be located in our selected list of nursing publications [13].

Publications dealing with gerontology and geriatrics are listed under our established subject headings; for example, a book on nutrition for the elderly is grouped with other books on nutrition. The section of our nursing list dealing with geriatric nursing contains citations to books that would be of value to allied health personnel caring for the elderly; geriatric nursing journals are also noted.

With only a few exceptions, association monographic publications have not been included in the book list, but we do want to emphasize their importance in developing allied health collections. Catalogs and brochures are available from associations like the American Association of Blood Banks, American Health Information Management Association, American Occupational Therapy Association, and American Physical Therapy Association.

Standard medical books and journals should be available to allied health personnel; likewise, dental auxiliary personnel also need to have access to standard dental books and journals. If there are no basic medical or dental collections in academic libraries supporting allied health education programs, access must be provided by means of neighboring health sciences libraries.

The revisions of our list of recommended books and journals in allied health are based upon our continuous monitoring of the literature over the past two

years, in addition to input received from librarians, allied health personnel, publishers, and book and journal vendors. The final decisions regarding the recommendation of books and journals are *ours*. We have tried to choose books that are authoritative in their fields, well organized, effectively indexed, readable, and used by allied health educators. In some allied health areas, it is a matter of identifying rather than choosing; this is especially true in the case of journals, where there is not much choice. Allied health literature is for the most part still a developing, diverse professional literature.

We intend that this list of books and journals be considered only as a *guide* for developing a collection of allied health literature; it is not to be used as a required item-by-item standard. Any publications list is relatively outdated as soon as it is published. Therefore, it is necessary for librarians to monitor the literature of allied health as it is published. Between revisions, this list will be updated on a quarterly basis in a newsletter titled *A Major Report* compiled and edited by the senior author [14]. Publishers' and vendors' listings and newsletters are useful sources for monitoring for current allied health publications.

The bibliographic and price information given here is as accurate as we could obtain at the time of publication, but price increases are likely to occur for many of the books and journals over time. Based upon the prices quoted, it would cost approximately \$26,740 to purchase the entire collection of books and journals. The 410 books cost about \$19,000 and the 76 journal subscriptions for 1996 amount to \$7,740. For books from publishers who follow net pricing procedures, we have used a book vendor's prices, which provide more realistic figures for library purchasing and budgeting purposes, since most libraries do not purchase directly from publishers but from vendors. Publishers' list prices are noted for all other books. The total cost for the entire collection, or for the individual subject category "Physical Therapy" (Table 1) includes only the specific books, e.g., items 236, 263, and 286, not the entire series. Subscription prices are institutional rates. Whenever member and non-member prices occur, the nonmember prices have been used in calculating the total costs. The average price per book title is \$46.36, and the average price of a 1996 journal subscription is \$101.88.

Items for initial purchase are indicated by asterisks before the titles. To purchase only the asterisked items (163 books and 31 journals), the total cost would be approximately \$11,160; the books total \$8,200 and the 1996 journal subscriptions, \$2,960. Due to the diversity of the subjects in this list, most people will probably not want to purchase all of the publications but instead will use the list selectively for programs pertinent to their particular situations. Table 1 shows the approximate cost for each subject section in the book

list. Overall total figures and average costs for this list are not as meaningful as those that we compile for the small medical library and for nursing, since it is not likely that all these allied health publications would ever be purchased totally as a collection.

Over the years, we have found that allied health books tend to go out of print at a faster rate than medical books; sometimes it is difficult to get this information from publishers. During the preparation of this list, several publishers were extremely uncooperative in supplying us needed information, and, from an academic point of view, we hope that we have been able to review their publications adequately by using other sources. On the other hand, some of their colleagues could not have been more helpful, and their assistance certainly has been appreciated.

The books in the list are arranged according to broad subject headings followed by an author/editor index. For new editions appearing in early 1996, we have indicated prices if they were available when we submitted the manuscript; if we could not obtain prices or tentative publication dates, we have used the

phrase "in preparation." In instances when a new edition will be available at a future time and the previous edition is still in print, we have listed that edition with a note regarding the preparation of a new one.

When a book has more than two authors or editors, the notation "[and others]" has been made after the name of the senior author or editor. In the book list, we have tried to indicate the publisher who is currently distributing the book. Because of takeovers and mergers that occur, the publisher shown on the title page may not always be the current distributor. If books are ordered from a vendor, this situation does not present a problem. In the author/editor index, only the names of the senior persons have been included; coauthors and coeditors have not. If the name of an original author or editor is an initial part of the title, we have included that name in the index. Journals have been arranged by broad subject categories, followed by an alphabetical title list.

We hope that our list of recommended allied health books and journals will continue to be a factor in upgrading allied health collections. Our introductory remarks relating to the status of allied health education provide merely a broad overview. We would suggest that you consult the references that we have cited on accreditation, allied health schools, and core curriculum to obtain more detailed information about what is going on in this most interesting health care field. We are in the midst of overwhelming changes in health care, and from all indications, the allied health professions face unprecedented opportunities that will continue to expand into the twenty-first century. Without question, this massive health care contingency will have major information needs. Will health sciences libraries have the collections to meet those needs?
