

**EVOLUTION.** For the article “The hallmark of AGC kinase functional divergence is its C-terminal tail, a cis-acting regulatory module,” by Natarajan Kannan, Nina Haste, Susan S. Taylor, and Andrew F. Neuwald, which appeared in issue 4, January 23, 2007, of *Proc Natl Acad Sci USA* (104:1272–1277; first published January 16, 2007; 10.1073/pnas.0610251104), the authors note that a grant number was inadvertently omitted. In the Acknowledgments, line 3, “National Institutes of Health Grant **IP01DK54441** (to S.S.T.)” should instead read: “National Institutes of Health Grants **IP01DK54441** and **GM19301** (to S.S.T.)”

**MICROBIOLOGY.** For the article “Mycobacterial persistence requires the utilization of host cholesterol,” by Amit K. Pandey and Christopher M. Sassetti, which appeared in issue 11, March 18, 2008, of *Proc Natl Acad Sci USA* (105:4376–4380; first published March 11, 2008; 10.1073/pnas.0711159105), the authors note that, due to a printer’s error, on page 4377, left column, the first sentence appeared incorrectly in part. “This finding suggested that this carbon was preferentially used for energy generation via the **trichloroacetic** acid cycle” should instead read: “This finding suggested that this carbon was preferentially used for energy generation via the **tricarboxylic** acid (TCA) cycle.” This error does not affect the conclusions of the article.
