In previous issues of this journal (1983, vol. 6, pp. 167–180; 1984, vol. 7, pp. 47–63), we offered detailed indices to the first two volumes of B. F. Skinner's autobiography, *Particulars of My Life* (Alfred A. Knopf, 1976) and *The Shaping of a Behaviorist* (Alfred A. Knopf, 1979). Below appears an index to the third volume, *A Matter of Consequences: Part Three of an Autobiography* (Alfred A. Knopf, 1983). It applies to both the hardcover and paperback editions.

The third volume, unlike the previous two, already contains an index. The new one is far more detailed: The one in the book has about 800 entries; this one has over 3,000.
