Erratum

In the article "The basic-applied continuum and the possible evolution of human operant social and verbal research" by Don F. Hake, a sentence has been interrupted by about 8 lines of words misplaced from other parts of the article.

The interrupted sentence is the last sentence that begins in column 1 on page 24 and continues into the second column. It should read as follows: "The major contention is that scientists should recognize that all aspects of their scientific behavior are shaped by the reinforcers of some scientific community and that this control of their behavior affects the science."

The misplaced words begin with "and" at the end of line 3 in column 2 and end with the word "control" in line 10.
