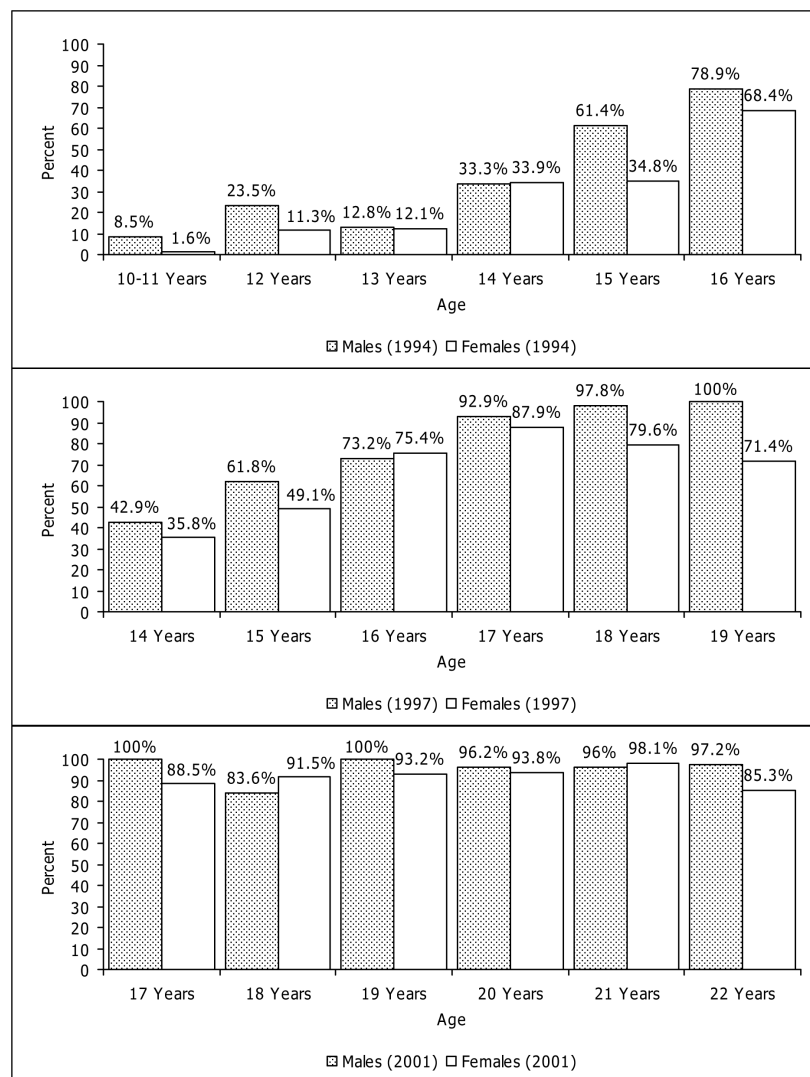


Figure 1 Frequencies of alcohol consumption (≥ 1 glass of alcohol) at three times.
