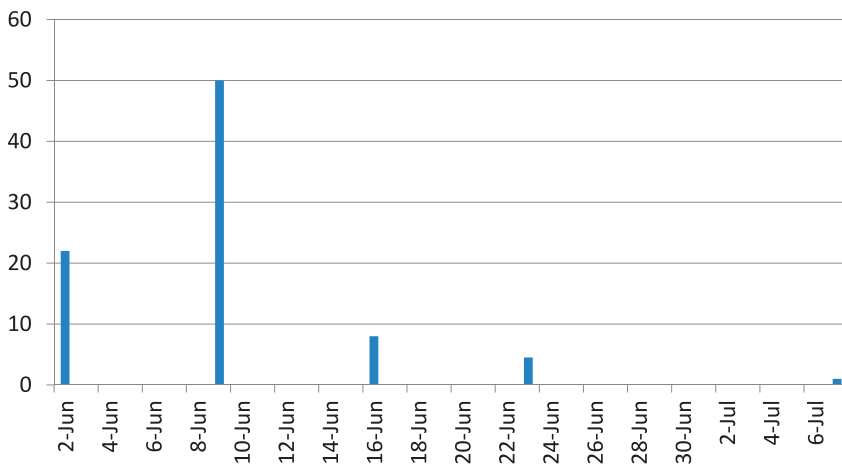




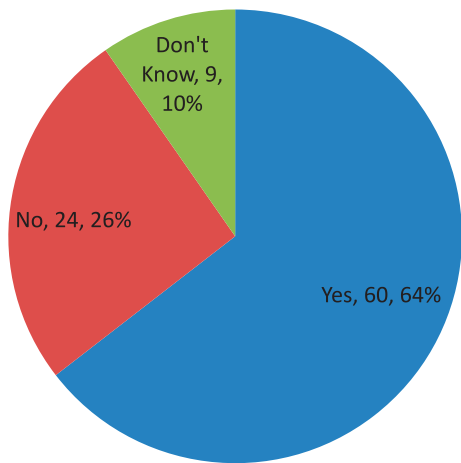

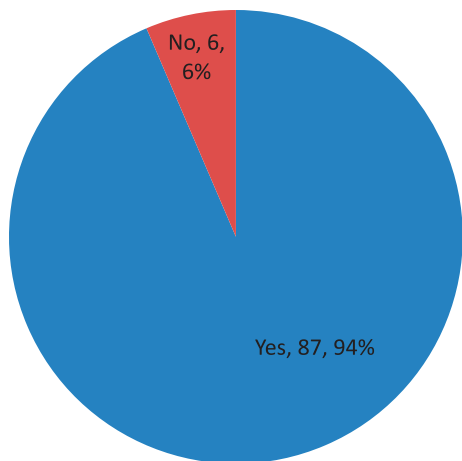
**Do you have patients who currently use cannabis (in any form) for seizure control?**

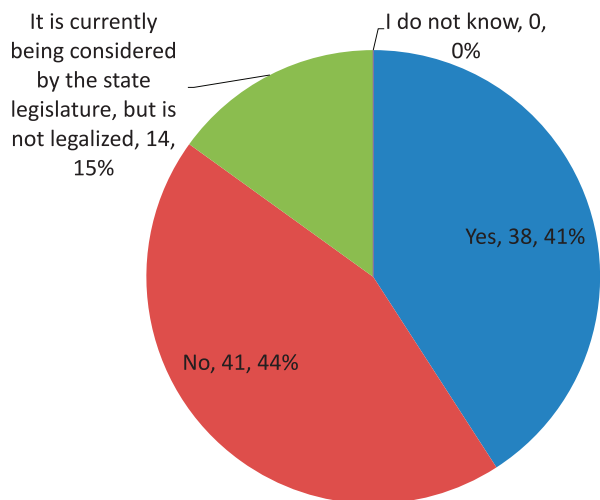


**Have you been contacted by patients seeking cannabis treatment for epilepsy?**

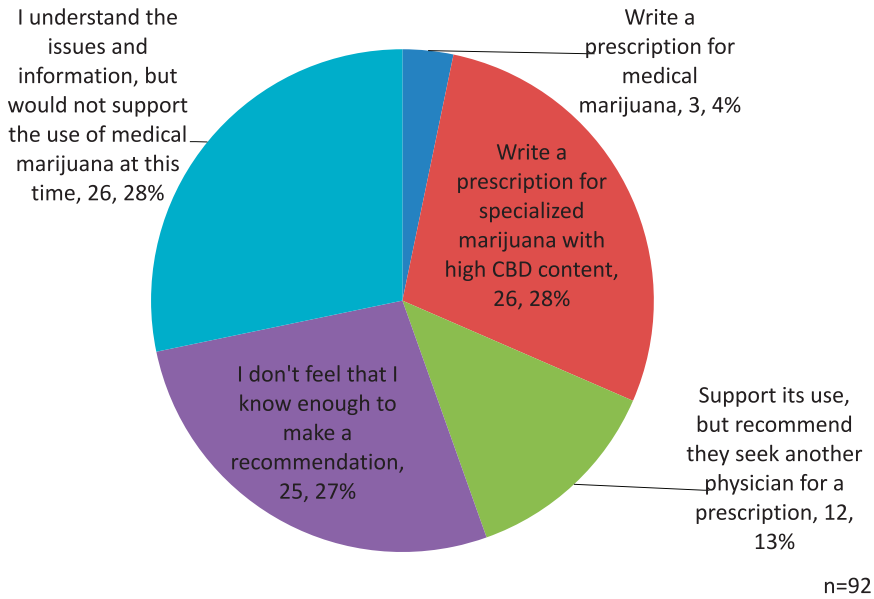

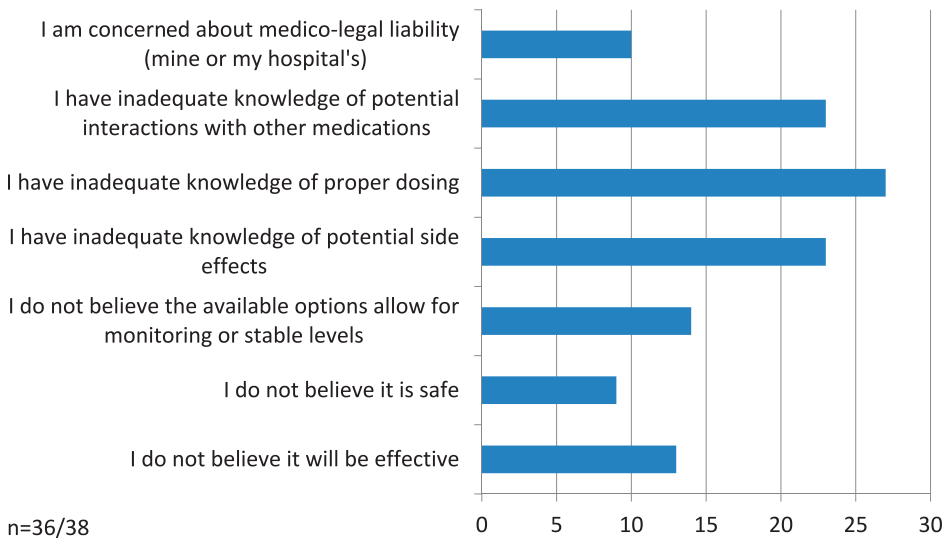

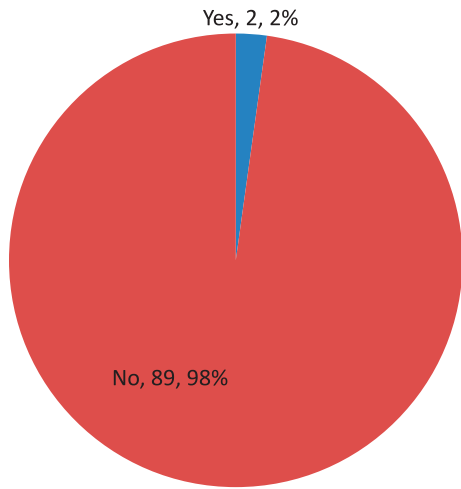

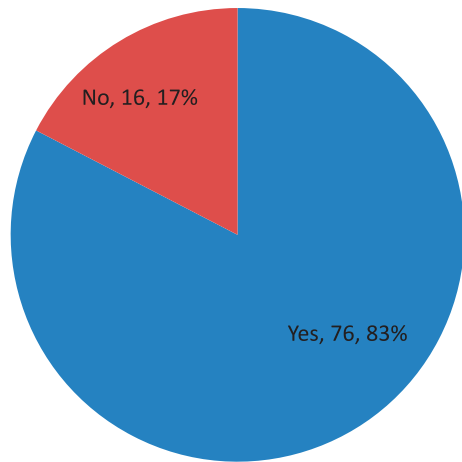

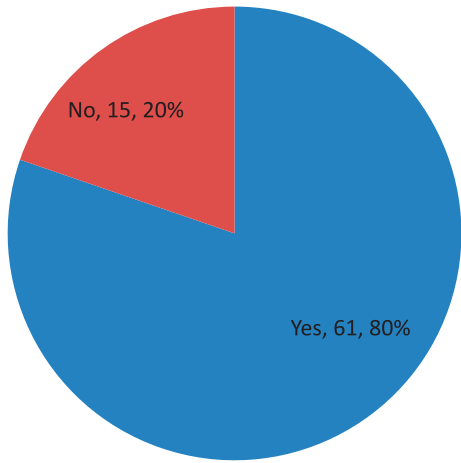

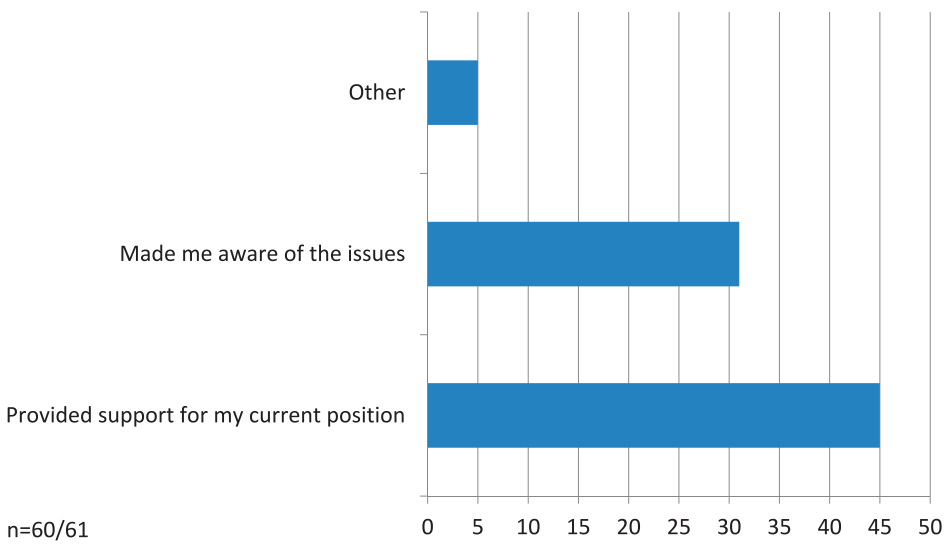
