

**Immunology.** In the article “Long-term repopulation of hematolymphoid cells with only a few hemopoietic stem cells in mice” by Hajime Ogata, W. Guy Bradley, Muneo Inaba, Nahoko Ogata, Susumu Ikehara, and Robert A. Good, which appeared in number 13, June 20, 1995, of *Proc. Natl. Acad. Sci. USA* (**92**, 5945–5949), the authors request that the following correction be noted. An error was made in recording the sequence of an antisense strand that was used as a control for analysis of the Y chromosome amplification. On p. 5946, left column, line 23, the antisense strand sequence should have been designated as 5'-ACTGCTGCTGCTTTCCAATA-3' instead of 5'-TAGTTGGAAGCAGCAGCAGT-3'.

In this paper we refer to protein sequences from myelin oligodendrocyte glycoprotein (MOG) when in fact those sequences are from a different protein, oligodendrocyte myelin glycoprotein (OMG).
