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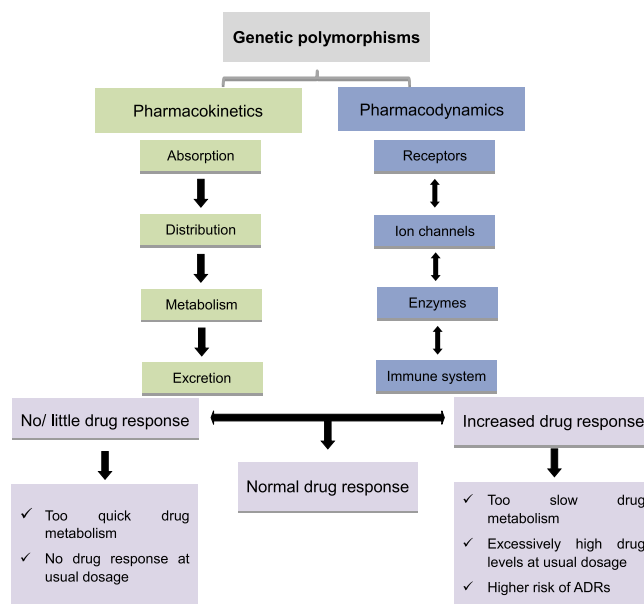


Figure 1 Effect of genetic polymorphisms on individuals' drug responses
