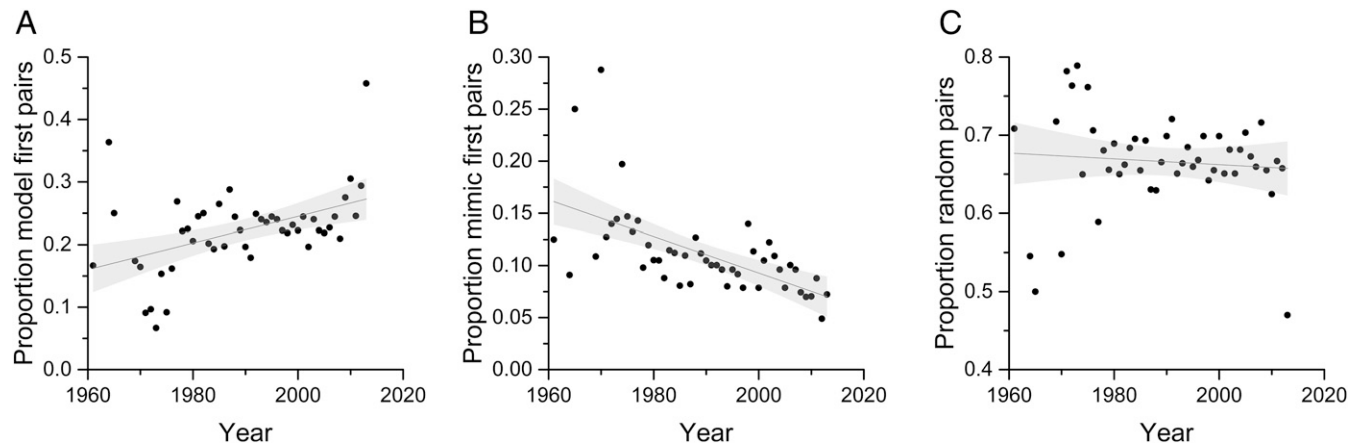


# Correction

Mimetic fidelity is derived from a large citizen science study, phenological trends are derived from >1 million biological records, and the three categories of emergence are defined using known fitness consequences from behavioral experiments. Shaded areas are 95% confidence intervals.
