In the article entitled “Experience of a Tertiary-Level Urology Center in Clinical Urological Events of Rare and Very Rare Incidence. V. Urological Tumors: 1. Adrenal Myelolipoma” published in *Current Urology* 2020;14(2):85–91 (DOI: 10.1159/000499254), the following Statement of Ethics was omitted: “According to the local legislation and institutional requirements, ethical review and approval for retrospective studies was not required.
