The authors have reported to *CHEST* that an error appeared in the text in “Optimal NIV Medicare Access

The error appears in the text of the section “Bilevel PAP for Patients Intolerant of CPAP” on page e413.

The correct text should read:

The current criteria should continue as they provide appropriate coverage to beneficiaries for an **E0470** (BPAP without a backup rate capability), when “an E0601 [CPAP] device has been tried and proven ineffective based on a therapeutic trial conducted in either a facility or in a home setting.”³
