- Low birthweight (<2500 grams) was determined from ICD-9 codes 764.xx (slow fetal growth and fetal malnutrition), 765.0x (extreme immaturity), and 765.1x (other preterm infants); the fifth digit indicates a birth weight category. The first code recorded within 28 days of an infant's birth was used to establish the weight category. If more than one code was assigned on the same day, the lowest recorded weight was used. Infants with no weight codes were assumed to be of normal birth weight.
- Preterm birth (< 37 completed weeks' gestation) was determined from ICD-9 codes 765.2x (weeks of gestation), 765.1x (other preterm infants), and 644.2x (early onset of delivery). Infants with no gestational age codes were assumed to be full term.
- **Major structural birth defect(s)** were defined by selected ICD-9 codes (see Table); categories of birth defects required relevant diagnoses in the first year of life, either on 1 inpatient record or 2 outpatient records on different days.
