

Supplementary Figure S4. State-specific annual fertility rate changes throughout the pandemic. All US states had declining fertility rates pre-coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID). Following the first two waves, we observed four general trends across US states: annual fertility rate declined further following Wave I but recovered by Wave 2; annual fertility rate declined further following Wave I and did not recover following Wave 2; annual fertility rate increased from baseline following Wave I and Wave 2; and annual fertility rate increased following Wave I but declined following Wave 2. Annual fertility rate change is average monthly births/100000 reproductive aged women/year.
