We retrieved publicly available data from National Institutes of Health (NIH) RePORTER database (reporter.nih.gov) for mentored K-awards and R01-equivalent grants from 1997 to 2021 to all departments in schools of medicine (including MDs, MD-PhDs, and PhDs). Mentored K-awards included K01, K07, K08, K18, K22, K23, K25, and K99. R01-equivalent grants are defined by the NIH to include DP1, DP2, DP5, R01, R29, R35, R37, RF1, RL1, and U01.¹
