

## **Supplementary Material**

Zero-order correlation between historical pathogen prevalence and days taken to lockdown, which is the number of days that had passed since the first identified COVID-19 case in a country before the country introduced lockdown measures, was significant (r = -.23, p < .05). Zero-order correlation between slow life history strategy and days taken to lockdown was significant (r = -.23, p < .05).

Zero-order correlation between historical pathogen prevalence and days taken to close schools, which is the number of days that had passed since the first identified COVID-19 case in a country before schools were ordered to close, was significant (r = -.25, p < .01). Zero-order correlation between slow life history strategy and days taken to close schools was significant (r = -.33, p < .001).




**Supplementary Fig. 1** Correlation between historical pathogen prevalence and (A) days taken to lockdown, (B) days taken to close schools

We also controlled for other potential social (i.e., Democratic Index), economic (i.e., GDP; Health expenditure as percentage of GDP), and health-related confounding variables (i.e., Total fertility rate per woman; Age-standardized mortality of all causes per 100,000 population). After controlling for all five variables, our hypothesized predictions involving both historical pathogen prevalence and slow LH strategy remain supported.
