

**External drivers index (EDI):** Used to assess the social, economic, cultural and other factors affecting One Health development, including the earth system, economic system, technological system, sociological system and institutional system

**Intrinsic drivers index (IDI):** Formed to assess One Health practice at the interfaces of human health, animal health and environment health

**Core drivers index (CDI):** Created to evaluate One Health implementation in the management of core scientific fields, including emerging zoonotic infectious diseases, food security, antimicrobial resistance (AMR), climate change and governance
