Free roaming cats: cats that are allowed to leave the house and the owner's property.

<u>Cat containment:</u> cats can be contained to prevent them from roaming freely. This includes keeping them indoors full-time or overnight, or when they are outside, keeping them in a cat escape-proof fenced yard or enclosure, on a harness and lead, or fully supervised.

<u>Cat escape-proof fence</u>: specially constructed fence that cats cannot jump or climb over and prevents cats from leaving the backyard or property. Standard backyard fences are NOT catproof.

<u>Cat enclosure:</u> an enclosed area (such as a purpose-built run or netted balcony area) where cats can access the outdoors but cannot roam freely.
