**Supplemental Table S2.** Community and Patient Partner Engagement in Women’s CVD Research Rapid Review (GRIPP 2-SF)

<b>Section and Topic</b>	<b>Item</b>
1.Aim	To scope the body of research where patient partners have been engaged in women’s CVD (IHD, heart failure, stroke) research.
2.Methods	Two patient partners collaborated throughout the review, identifying priorities and search terms from a contemporaneous review through to reviewing the manuscript prior to publication. Patient partners are listed as co-authors on the manuscript. Compensation was provided to patient partners using recommendations from the SPOR Chronic Disease Networks and the Primary Integrated Health Care Innovations (PIHCI).
3.Results	Patient partners will be instrumental in providing other recommendations for sharing and disseminating rapid review findings. This may include co-delivering results via social media, public forums, as well as scientific presentations in which they will be invited to be a co-presenter.
4.Discussion	Co-authors (i.e., patient partners) have collaborated in previous reviews and the principal author (MP) is experienced in involving patient partners in her research.
5.Reflections	Patient engagement was embedded as much as possible into the methods of this review. This built on previous collaborations with the same patient partners, noting that the principles of inclusiveness, support, mutual respect, flexibility, accountability, and co-learning was already established between team members/co-authors.
