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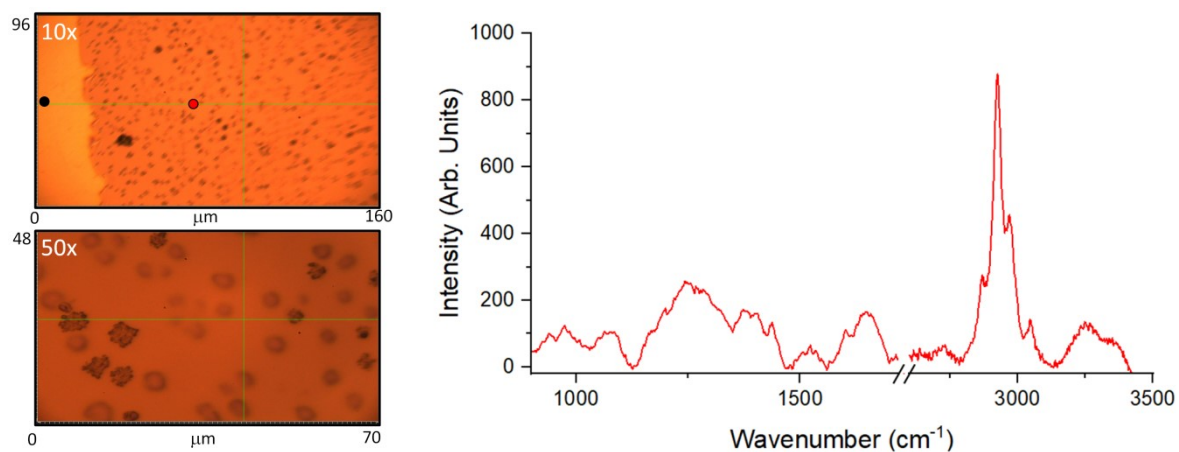

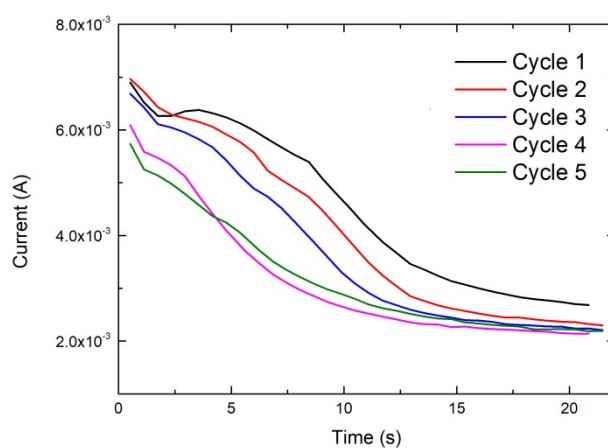


Fig. S2. Current fluctuation versus time recorded from cycle 1 to cycle 5 of Fig. 5b.
