Inclusion criteria:

- > Date of publication: up to 10 years ago
- ➤ Language: English
- Study design: ALL
- ➤ Population: primarily focused on key populations (e.g., young individuals, migrants, sex workers, MSM, transgender people, gender diverse people, bisexual and homosexual men, swingers, PWID, PLWHIV)
- ➤ Intervention: home-based comprehensive sexual health care with (online) self-sampling for HIV and/or STI testing and AT LEAST one of these care elements:
 - o Results provision
 - o Treatment
 - o Partner notification
 - o Health promotion/prevention
 - o Retesting/repeat testing
- > Studies should report AT LEAST one of these **outcomes** and/or **constructs*** (Following PRISM outcomes)

Exclusion criteria:

- Non-human studies
- > Validation studies with only test related results (sensitivity, specificity)
- ➤ Intervention has <u>no HIV testing component</u>
 - Unless key population is HIV positive
