- Examination or description of care profiles, or patient characteristics
- Analysis of patient, family, or healthcare provider's needs during TiC
- Analysis of delays (frequency, risk factors, length and effect on patient outcomes)
- Evaluation, review or implementation of an intervention or program
- Description, review or analysis focussed on continuity of care
- Examination of adverse events or patient outcomes related TiC
- Examination of economics (cost or cost-effectiveness) related to TiC

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
