


Figure 1 Breakdown of drugs (both courses and single doses) given by emergency nurse practitioners (ENPs) between February and July 1996. NSAIDS, non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs.

There is an uncorrected error in fig 1, with missing legends. The corrected figure is reproduced alongside.
