## Errata (continued)

Several errors appeared inadvertently in the article "A Review of State Legislation on DNA Forensic Data Banking" by McEwen and Reilly (54:941–958). The relevant statutes in California and Hawaii cover only felony offenses; they do not include any misdemeanors (either sex related or otherwise). In addition, the Arizona and Missouri statutes do not cover any offenses other than sex-related offenses,

and the Kentucky statute covers only sex-related felonies. Finally, Illinois should be added to the list of states that have published administrative regulations on DNA forensic data banking (table 4, p. 944) and should be removed from the list of states that collect saliva samples in addition to blood (table 8, p. 947).
