Selected list of books and journals in allied health*

This list of 396 books and 77 journals is intended as a selection guide to be used in a library supporting allied health educational programs or allied health personnel in either an academic or health care setting. Due to the necessity of limiting the scope of coverage because of the large number and wide range of allied health professions and occupations, the recommended publications are focused primarily on the twenty-eight programs accredited by the Committee on Allied Health Education and Accreditation of the American Medical Association, plus physical therapy, dental allied health, medical secretarial, nutrition, and speech pathology/audiology. Books and journals are categorized by subject; the book list is followed by an author/editor index, and the subject list of journals is followed by an alphabetical title listing. Items suggested for initial purchase (194 books and 31 journals) are indicated by asterisks. To purchase the entire collection of books and journals (1992 subscriptions) would require an expenditure of about \$22,800. The cost of only the asterisked items totals \$10,850.

The list of recommended allied health books and journals that follows is the result of an ongoing project that we began more than ten years ago for the primary purpose of developing a selection guide to serve the collection development needs of academic and health science librarians. At that time, allied health literature had not been scrutinized or organized bibliographically in a systematic manner; our first allied health list was published in 1984, three years after we had begun our initial work [1].

The importance and necessity of allied health personnel in the biomedical community is beyond question. There is an awareness, particularly by the American Medical Association (AMA), of the severity of the current decline in allied health personnel with resulting dire consequences to the health care of the public [2–3]. Nevertheless, all too often allied health seems to be relegated to an "orphan" status when compared with medicine, nursing, and dentistry. Maybe it is because there is a lack of visibility at the federal level. The words allied health do not appear on any official government door. There is no Division of Allied Health Professions nor is there a National Commission on Allied Health. The manpower shortage problem is compounded because there is no national, uniform allied health data system [4]. We have observed that the orphan status likewise tends to extend to allied health literature, particularly in biomedical libraries that do not support allied health educational programs. When the budget gets tight, allied health seems to be one of the first areas to be crunched. But how long can we as health sciences librarians push this literature aside?

In September 1990, the Public Health Service released a document titled *Healthy People 2000: National*

Health Promotion and Disease Prevention Objectives [5]. This report outlines the health goals for the nation over the next ten years. Its content is derived from health professionals, citizens, private organizations, and public agencies nationwide. The work on this document began in 1987 and involved more than 10,000 people. Although the federal government facilitated their development, the goals are those of the participants; they are not government standards or requirements. For everyone, and especially for health sciences librarians, Healthy People 2000 should be considered as a landmark publication whose content has to be widely disseminated. This publication has come about at a time when the universal U.S. perception is that medical care is too expensive, and worries about access and cost outweigh all other concerns. The report stresses health promotion and disease prevention as the alternatives to the "sick care" that we are all too likely to experience today. The report envisions the twenty-first century as being characterized by an enhanced quality of extended life, reduced disparity in the health status of populations in our society, and significant reductions in preventable death and disabilities.

As we read this document, it became very clear that it would take far more than our traditional health care providers-physicians, nurses, and dentists-to achieve the ambitious goals of Healthy People 2000. The report focuses on contemporary health problems in which allied health personnel must take on fundamental roles. They will have to be involved in decision making to a much greater extent than they have been in the past and, in reality, become integral components of health care teams characterized by complementary relationships instead of the traditional leader-follower scenario. As health sciences librarians, we must recognize and prepare for the informational needs of all health care providers. And we should again remind ourselves that the largest segment of health care personnel is allied health. Estimates of their numbers range from 1 to 5 million, in as many as 200 professions and occupations covering the gamut from on-the-job trained workers to highly educated, skilled professionals employed in a variety of health care settings.

Early on when we undertook the groundbreaking project of compiling a list of recommended books and journals in allied health, we established subject scope guidelines and have essentially adhered to them in subsequent updates. We no longer are attempting to define *allied health* since the Institute of Medicine (NAS/IOM) Committee to Study the Role of Allied Health Personnel chose not to come up with or search for a definition [6]. We have excluded the literature of the health professions that are generally considered autonomous: chiropractic, dentistry, medicine, nursing, optometry, osteopathy, pharmacy, podiatry, and veterinary medicine. We have tried to put together a collection of books and journals that will support the twenty-eight educational programs accredited by the Committee on Allied Health Education and Accreditation (CAHEA) of AMA, which are described in detail in the *Allied Health Education Directory* [7]. In 1990, CAHEA approved a new program, Athletic Trainer, and while our list covers anatomy, physiology, and physical therapy, we have not reviewed publications geared specifically for the athletic trainer. Perhaps we shall add this category in the next update; the sports medicine section in our hospital list is also relevant to this program [8].

Besides the CAHEA programs, we have included physical therapy, dental hygiene and assisting, medical secretarial, and nutrition. We chose the additional categories because physical therapy is one of the fastest growing professions in the health care field. The next two subjects were selected because of the large number of programs existing for both dental auxiliary personnel and medical secretaries. We had numerous requests from librarians to include nutrition. In this update, we have added a new category, Speech Pathology/Audiology, since it is among the professions addressed by the NAS/IOM study [9]. Publications dealing with gerontology and geriatrics are listed under our established subject headings; for example, a book on nutrition for the elderly is grouped with other books on nutrition. The section of our nursing list dealing with geriatric nursing contains citations to books that would be of value to allied health personnel caring for the elderly; geriatric nursing journals are also noted [10].

A distinct literature for some allied health programs does not exist. Educational programs for the physician assistant rely heavily upon books in the basic and behavioral sciences as well as standard medical texts and journals; medical publications can be identified from our list of recommended books and journals for the small medical library. Physician assistant programs also make use of publications in related allied health fields. Programs for the surgeon assistant and surgical technologist are supported heavily by the literature of perioperative nursing as well as a variety of surgical publications; related nursing titles can be located in our list of nursing publications.

As a rule, we have selected books and journals focused specifically on allied health, but if a medical text or journal is an integral part of the literature of an allied health discipline, it has been included. We have put an emphasis on *current* materials, predominantly of U.S. origin, although some Canadian and a few British publications have been included. For some subject categories like Physician Assistant or Surgical Technology, most of the current books we could identify are several years old. All the books that we have selected have been published since 1986; 72% since 1990. New editions of eleven important books scheduled for 1993 have been cited. Only 2% of the books are dated prior to 1988. We have chosen the most current books available because rapidly changing technology has a strong impact on many allied health professions and occupations. Because of our doing this, older books do not appear in this list, but they may have been included in earlier ones. We are aware that "new" does not necessarily mean "better."

We have recommended a few self-study books because these publications are frequently used as teaching tools in allied health education programs. Anyone wanting to locate more of them should contact publishers such as Appleton & Lange, Brady (Prentice Hall), Medical Examination Publishing Company (Elsevier), Mosby-Year Book, and Saunders. Subject-oriented "word books" for medical transcriptionists have been deleted from the Terminology category of the book list. Springhouse Book Company has reprinted many of these books that were originally published by Slack, Inc.

With one or two exceptions, association monographic publications have not been included in the book list, but we do want to emphasize their importance in developing allied health collections. Catalogs and brochures are available from associations like the American Association of Blood Banks, American Health Information Management Association, American Occupational Therapy Association, and American Physical Therapy Association.

Standard medical books and journals should be available to allied health personnel; likewise, dental auxiliary personnel also need to have access to standard dental books and journals. If there are no basic medical or dental collections in academic libraries supporting allied health education programs, access must be provided by means of neighboring health sciences libraries.

We have revised our list of recommended books and journals in allied health based upon our continuous monitoring of the literature over the past two years, in addition to input received from librarians, allied health personnel, publishers, and book and journal vendors. The final decision regarding the recommendation of books and journals is *ours*. We have tried to choose books that are authoritative in their fields, well organized, effectively indexed, readable, and used by allied health educators. In some allied health areas, it is a matter of identifying rather than choosing; this is especially true in the case of journals. Allied health literature is for the most part still a developing diverse professional literature.

The fact is certainly recognized by allied health educators. Articles are appearing on the readability of allied health journals [11-12]; the importance of upgrading educational programs to meet the demands of the twenty-first century [13–14]; research in allied health [15–16] and health informatics [17– 18]. A recently published book entitled *Information Searching in Health Care* provides a clear, concise introduction to making the most effective use of available information resources, both print and electronic [19].

This list is intended to serve as a selection guide for developing a collection of allied health literature. It should not be considered as a required item-byitem standard. Unfortunately, selection lists tend to be somewhat outdated by the time they appear in print, and this one is no exception. It merely provides a basis for developing an allied health collection, but librarians must keep up to date on new books and journals as they are published. Our allied health list will be updated on a quarterly basis in a newsletter titled A Major Report compiled and edited by the senior author [20]. Since 1984, the Cumulative Index to Nursing & Allied Health Literature (CINAHL) has contained a list of new nursing and allied health books that are arranged by CINAHL subject headings and alphabetically by author [21]; it is not a recommended list of books.

We have found few current selection sources that would assist a librarian unfamiliar with allied health publications in acquiring such a collection. Last year there was an extensive bibliography of nutrition journals [22] and a chiropractic core collection [23] published. Other relatively recent publications that might be useful are an annotated bibliography on the fundamentals of geriatrics for health professionals [24] and a core collection of approximately 1,000 print and nonprint media in nursing and allied health [25]. Listings and newsletters from health science book and journal vendors provide valuable information for locating allied health publications.

The bibliographic and price information given here is as accurate as we could obtain at the time of publication, but subsequent price increases are to be expected. Based upon the prices quoted, it would cost approximately \$22,800 to purchase the entire collection of books and journals. The 396 books cost about \$16,750, and the 77 journal subscriptions for 1992 amount to \$6,050. For books from publishers who follow net pricing, we have used a book vendor's prices, which provide more realistic figures for purchasing and budgeting purposes since most libraries do not purchase directly from publishers but from vendors. Publishers' list prices are noted for all other books. The total cost for the entire collection, or for the individual subject category Physical Therapy (Table 1), includes only the specific books designated, e.g., items 222, 227, and 233, not the entire series. Subscription prices shown are institutional rates. Whenever member and nonmember prices occur, nonmember prices have been used in calculating total

costs. The average price per book title is \$42.27, and the average price of a 1992 journal subscription is \$78.57.

Items for initial purchase are indicated by asterisks before the title. To purchase only the asterisked items (194 books and 31 journal subscriptions), the total cost would be approximately \$10,850—\$8,600 for books and \$2,250 for 1992 journal subscriptions. The subjects covered in this list are diverse, and probably most people will not want to purchase all of the publications but instead will use the list selectively for programs relevant to their particular situations. Table 1 shows the approximate cost of each section in the book list. Total figures and average costs of books and journals for this list are not as meaningful as those that we compile for the small medical library or nursing because all of these allied health publications will probably never be purchased in toto as a collection.

The books in the list are arranged according to broad subject headings followed by an author/editor index. For new editions appearing in 1992, we have indicated prices if available when we submitted the manuscript; if prices were not available, we have used "In preparation." The same phrase has also been used for new editions due in 1993. Allied health books tend to go out of print faster than do medical books; sometimes it is difficult to obtain this information from publishers when we are compiling the list. When a book has more than two authors or editors, the notation "[and others]" is made after the name of the senior author or editor. In the book list, we have indicated the publisher who is currently distributing the book. Due to various takeovers and mergers that have occurred and are likely to continue to occur, the publisher shown on the title page may not always be the current distributor. If books are ordered from vendors, this situation does not present a problem. In the author/editor index, only the names of the senior persons are included; coauthors and coeditors are not. If the name of an original author or editor is an initial part of the title, we have put that name in the index. Journals are arranged by broad subject categories, followed by an alphabetical title list.

The critical role of allied health personnel in the current health care environment is well documented throughout the literature. As the nation's attention turns to health promotion, disease prevention, and quality of life, the demand for highly trained allied health practitioners will continue to increase dramatically. We as health science librarians are challenged to increase our delivery of biomedical information to the expanding range of health care providers on an equivalent basis. Hopefully, our allied health literature project will contribute to this objective.
