Brandon/Hill selected list of books and journals in allied health*

This list of 410 books and 78 journals is intended as a selection guide to be used in a library supporting allied health educational programs or allied health personnel in either an academic or health care setting. Because of the impossibility of covering the large number and wide variety of allied health professions and occupations, the recommended publications are focused primarily on the educational programs listed and described in the AMA's Health Professions Education Directory, 1997–1998, plus physical therapist and medical secretary. Some programs do not have their own specific literatures. Books and journals are categorized by subject; the book list is followed by an author/editor index, and the subject list of journals by an alphabetical title listing. Items suggested for initial purchase (160 books and 31 journals) are indicated by asterisks. To purchase the entire collection of books and journals (1998 subscriptions) would require an expenditure of about \$29,180. The cost of only the asterisked items totals \$11,390.

The list of recommended allied health books and journals that follows is the eighth version of an article originally published in 1984 by Alfred N. Brandon and me [1]. We continued to update this work biennially until his death in July 1996. At that time we had just returned the corrected galley proofs for the 1996 update of the allied health list. This current revision has been done by me, attempting to follow the procedures that we had used when we worked together on this project. Because this is my late coauthor's concept, I believe that his name should appear in the title of this and subsequent revisions as the "Brandon/Hill Selected

List of Books and Journals in Allied Health." For many years it has been known as "Brandon/Hill."

However, I cannot and will not take complete credit for this update. A year or so after Alfred Brandon's death, I realized that I could not carry on the three "Brandon/Hill Selected Lists" at the same quality level that had previously existed without some assistance. I had just begun to work on the 1998 nursing list when a longtime Levy Library colleague, Henry Stickell, offered to help out in any way that he could. After discussing the matter, we both felt that he could make a much needed contribution by carrying out support tasks such as preparing lists of questions for publishers, reviewing publishers' correspondence, proofreading, or compiling author/editor indexes among other things. He has made a significant contribution in the preparation of the manuscripts for both the 1998 up-

dates of the nursing and the allied health lists. His help saved me hours of time that I was able to devote to the book and journal selection process. I have carefully considered all of the input—pro and con—that I have received from allied health faculty, librarians, publishers, and vendors, but the final choice of books and journals is *mine* based on *my opinion*. All of the "Brandon/Hill Selected Lists" have always been based on opinion; there is no secret scientific formula.

Alfred Brandon and I became interested in allied health literature as a result of the success of our "Selected List of Nursing Books and Journals," which we published in 1979 [2]. We received many requests from librarians and allied health faculty who wanted to know if we could make up a comparable list for allied health literature. Nothing like it was available, and these people perceived that the need was great. During the early 1980s, allied health programs that traditionally had been hospital-based were beginning to be transferred to academic settings—four-year colleges, two-year junior colleges, and community colleges. Many persons in these libraries had little or no knowledge of acquiring allied health literature.

We became more and more aware that informational resources for allied health personnel, the largest segment of the health care work force in the United States, were not only sparse in academic libraries but also in health sciences libraries, large and small, as well. What was needed was a selected list of allied health books and journals to assist inexperienced selectors in a variety of libraries.

In the fall of 1981, we made a commitment to add a third selected list (allied health) to our project. Alfred Brandon felt that rounding up the literature of allied health would be worthwhile and challenging; he was correct! Before we could do anything, we had to define our scope of coverage because there was no universally accepted definition of the term "allied health." Even today the definition is elusive, and many people seem to have ceased hunting for it.

Because this list may be used by individuals not familiar with previous versions, it might be helpful to review the parameters that we used to determine subject coverage and intended purpose. Most of the sources that we consulted did not designate autonomous health professions such as medicine, osteopathy, dentistry, veterinary medicine, pharmacy, or optometry under the allied health "umbrella." Some sources included nursing as an allied health profession while others did not. We already had compiled a list of nursing literature, so for our purposes, we added nursing to the autonomous group. After excluding those eight groups, we were still facing over 200 discrete allied health professions and occupations ranging from acute care to chronic care.

In order to make this project realistic, we decided to compile a list of books and journals that would predominantly support the twenty-six educational programs then accredited by the AMA Committee on Allied Health Education and Accreditation (CAHEA) and listed in the Allied Health Education Directory [3]. Because of numerous requests, we also included the literature of allied dental personnel and medical secretaries. Currently, the Health Professions Education Directory, 1997-1998, lists forty allied health programs (fourteen more than in the 1982 Directory) but the American Medical Association no longer accredits them. Instead they are accredited by thirteen different agencies. The increase in the number of programs does not mean that there were fourteen that we did not-address. Some of them were already in the allied health list and other specific programs were covered by the broad subject breakdown that we used in this list.

In some instances, a distinct literature for a program in allied health does not exist. For example even though there are now a few books written for the physician assistant, the program still relies heavily on standard medical texts and journals and books in the basic and behavioral sciences. Programs for surgical technologists are supported heavily by both perioperative nursing and surgical literature. Books and journals to augment an allied health literature collection in the fields of nursing and medicine can be found in the latest "Brandon/Hill Selected Lists" [5, 6]. Assembling a dental library collection has been made much easier by a recently published list of recommended books and journals in clinical dentistry [7].

We added Nutrition to the 1988 allied health list for the first time because of frequent user requests. The major event of the 1980s affecting allied health was the National Academy of Sciences/Institute of Medicine (NAS/IOM) eighteen-month study on the role of allied health personnel in health care delivery [8]. In this study, ten groups of allied health personnel—clinical laboratory technologists and technicians, dental hygienists, dietitians, emergency medical personnel, medical record administrators and technicians, occupational therapists, physical therapists, radiological technologists and technicians, respiratory therapists, and speech-language pathologists and audiologistswere selected. These groups were chosen because they were large and well-known, spanned the spectrum of autonomy, and included practitioners who worked in a variety of health care settings. We had covered all but one of the ten groups in our allied health list, speech pathology and audiology. In view of the NAS/ IOM study, we extended our coverage to include Speech Pathology / Audiology.

From the preceding narrative, it is easy to realize that the list of allied health publications recommended here is not the be-all and end-all authority in allied health collection development. However, it is a convenient guide for setting up such a collection or updating an already existing one. It also provides a quick

source for determing what is being published, especially in books. The choice of books and journals has resulted from my having monitored the allied health literature for the past two years.

However, every allied health publication has not passed over my desk. Books or journals might be missing from this list simply because I did not see them. The amount of allied health literature that I do see is tied very tightly to publisher participation. If I were asked to set up a book and journal collection for allied health personnel, the titles I have listed here represent the collection I would have purchased at the time I submitted this manuscript. My choices may have been different a month or even a week later.

I have attempted to assemble a well-balanced collection of allied health books and journals geared specifically to allied health personnel whenever possible. In selecting publications for the allied health list, I tried to evaluate each title, first as I thought Alfred Brandon would have—and then from my point of view and tried to reconcile the two. Most of the publications originate in the United States, but there are also some British and Canadian publications. As the name of this list implies, only books and journals in print format have been evaluated.

All of the books that I have chosen have been published from 1989 through 1998; only one was published before 1990, and 92% from 1995 to date. I have picked out the most current books available because rapidly changing technology has a strong impact on many allied health professions and occupations. As a result, older books do not appear in this list, but they may have appeared in earlier versions. Nearly 40% of the titles in the 1998 book list have been changed from the 1996 one. The journals remain relatively stable from list to list. There have been minor changes in the journal list for the Emergency Medical Technology and Speech Pathology/Audiology sections. I realize that "new" does not necessarily mean "better," but current literature has a priority in this setting.

The bibliographic and price information quoted here is as accurate as I could obtain at the time the manuscript was submitted, but price increases are likely over time. Based upon the prices that I have, it would cost approximately \$29,180 to purchase the entire collection of books and journals. The 410 books cost about \$19,500, and the 78 journal subscriptions for 1998 amount to \$9,680. For books from publishers that have dual pricing (list/net or retail/net or something similar), I have quoted the higher prices. The total price for the entire collection or for the individual category "Physical Therapy" includes only the specific book cited in Item 242, not the entire series. Whenever member and nonmember prices exist, I have used higher nonmember prices. Other prices are publishers' traditional list prices. Subscription prices are quoted at institutional rates; sometimes subscription prices for individ-

uals are somewhat less than for institutions. The average price per book title is \$47.59, and the average price of a 1998 journal subscription is \$124.17.

Items for initial purchase are indicated by asterisks before the titles. To purchase only the asterisked items (160 books and 31 journal subscriptions) would cost approximately \$11,390-\$8,000 for books and \$3,390 for journal subscriptions. Due to the diversity of the subjects covered in this list, most people will probably not want to purchase all of the publications but instead will use the list selectively for subjects pertinent to their particular situations. Table 1 shows the approximate cost for each subject section of the book list. Overall total figures and average costs for this list are not as meaningful as those that we compile for the small medical library and for nursing, because it is not likely that all these allied health publications would ever be purchased totally as a collection. This list represents the literature of several professions, not just

As I have mentioned, when Alfred Brandon and I first compiled the list of recommended allied health

books and journals nearly fourteen years ago, there were no up-to-date selection guides. Aside from this one, the same situation exists today. In 1995, Doody's Nursing and Allied Health Review Quarterly began publication; it reviews publications of interest to nursing and allied health personnel, but only about 20% of the content relates to allied health [9]. Last year, it was gratifying to find several articles on the mapping of allied health literature. These bibliometric studies came about as a result of the Nursing and Allied Health Resources Section of the Medical Library Association creating a Task Force on Bibliographic Access for the Allied Health Literature. Five professions were studied: health education, physical therapy, radiologic technology, respiratory therapy, and speech-language pathology. More such studies are in process. This research should provide a better understanding of bibliographic access to potential allied health core literature [10–15]. Another use study of speech-pathology and audiology periodicals was carried out at Illinois State University [16]. These papers reflect a growing interest in the literature of allied health by health sciences literarians. The future of allied health will be very different from the present. Little has been done to understand and mobilize this massive workforce. The current status and future potential of allied health in the United States have been brought together in the "Report of the National Commission on Allied Health" [17]. It examines allied health issues relative to education, workforce supply and demand, work environments, licensure, accreditation, research, practice, government intervention, and managed care.

The books in this list are arranged according to thirty-five broad subject headings followed by an author/editor index. When a book has more than two authors or editors, the notation "[and others]" has been made after the name of the senior author or editor. In the author/editor index only the names of the senior persons have been included; coauthors and coeditors have not. If the name of an original author or editor is an initial part of the title, it has been included.

New editions scheduled for mid- and late-1998 publication, which have tentative prices and release dates, have been considered as published. If I did not know the price or a tentative publication date for a scheduled 1998 book, it has been designated by the phrase "in preparation." For updated editions scheduled throughout 1999, I have listed the current available edition followed by a note that a new edition is scheduled for 1999. Because of mergers, takeovers, and the changing of publishers' names, the imprint on the book may not necessarily be the publisher who is distributing it. As a matter of course, I have routinely cited the publisher from whom the book is availabe in the United States. Journals are arranged according to twenty broad subject headings, followed by an alphabetical title list.

All three "Brandon/Hill" lists (allied health, small medical library, and nursing) will continue to be updated between published biennial revisions in *A Major Report*, a quarterly newsletter put out by Majors Scientific Books that was originally compiled and edited by Alfred Brandon for many years [18]. My late coauthor and I have held to the premise that the literature supporting the largest segment of the health care industry must become a substantial part of the biomedical collection and be acquired in a comparable manner extended to medicine, nursing, and dentistry. I hope that my continuing to compile this list of recommended books and journals will likewise continue to be a guide in upgrading allied health collections.
