<b>Male: Female ratio</b>	Same or higher than for MSS tumors	Lower than for MSS tumors
<b>Age at diagnosis</b>	Similar to MSS tumors, with suggestion of increase >70 years of age	U-shaped pattern of risk relative to MSS tumors
<b>Fam Hx of CRC</b>	Similar to MSS tumors	Much more frequent than MSS tumors. After removal of Amsterdam families, same frequency as MSS tumors
<b>Fam Hx of endometrial cancer</b>	Same or slightly more frequent than MSS tumors	Much more frequent than MSS tumors
