Australian and New Zealand Standardised Occupational Classification Codes

1. Managers:

General managers, chief executives, company directors, legislators, farmers and farm managers, specialist managers, hospitality and retail/sales managers.

2. Professionals:

Professionals working in the areas of arts and design, media, business, human resource and marketing, engineering, science, transport, education, health, IT, and legal services.

3. Technicians and trade workers:

Engineering, computing and science technicians, electricians, hairdressers, animal handlers, and trade workers in the automotive, construction, food, telecommunication, electronics, horticultural industries.

4. Community and personal service workers:

Health and welfare support workers, personal care assistants, child minders, educational aides, hospitality workers, defensive and emergency force members, prison and security officers, sports and fitness centre workers.

5. Clerical and administrative workers:

Office managers, program administrators, secretaries, receptionists, and clerical/ administration staff.

6. Sales workers:

Sales representatives and agents, retail assistants, checkout operators, and office chasers.

7. Machinery operators and drivers:

Mobile and stationary plant operators, store-persons, and drivers of automobiles, taxis, buses, trains, delivery vans, and trucks.

8. Labourers:

Construction and mining labourers, cleaners and laundry workers, packers, shelf fillers, product assemblers, food preparation assistants, freight handlers, food process workers, farm and forestry workers.
