

<u>Fig. S2</u> Nifedipine blocks glucose-stimulated exocytosis as measured by TIRFM. βTC3 cells were transfected with SEP-VAMP2, and secretory granule exocytosis was observed using TIRFM. Glucose-starved cells were stimulated with 8 mM glucose alone, or pretreated with 25 μM nifedipine before glucose stimulation. Sum changes to baseline fluorescence were quantified for 30 frames following glucose treatment and normalized to the glucose-treated condition. The * indicates statistical significance (P<0.05, two-tailed t-test, N=6), and error bars indicate the SEM.
