


Figure S1. Current career choice of UCSF doctoral students

Bar graph shows percentage of all student respondents who chose each category as their current career choice. Bars in dark blue represent research careers; bars in light blue represent non-research careers.




Figure S2. Confidence in current career choice drops during the second year in graduate studies.

When students were asked to rate their confidence in their current career choice, 54.9% of all respondents reported the lowest level of confidence, “I am still considering a range of options.” 29.3% of all respondents reported “I am fairly confident in this career choice.” Only 15.8% of all respondents reported “I am very confident in this career choice.” Confidence in career choice depended on stage of graduate training, as shown in this graph.
