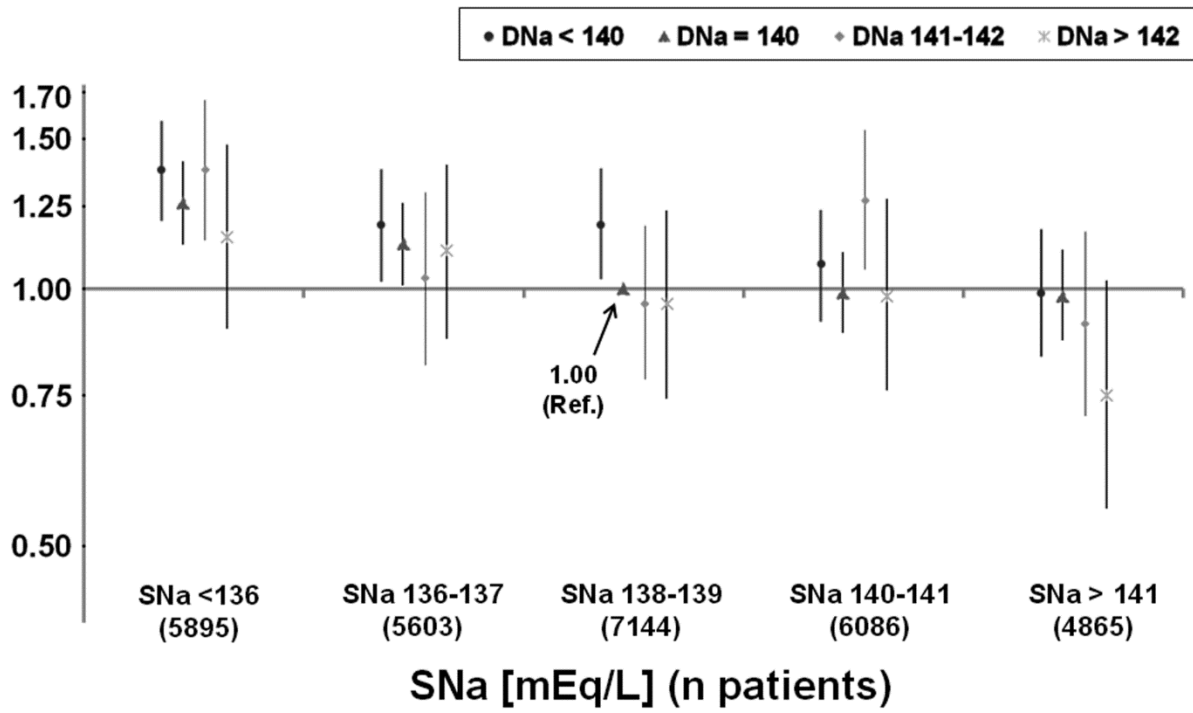
Supplementary Figure 1: Adjusted all-cause mortality risk by dialysate sodium (DNa) and predialysis serum sodium (SNa).

Cox model, as in Figure 3, but additionally adjusted for interdialytic weight gain (IDWG) and predialysis systolic blood pressure (SBP).

Supplementary Figure 2: Adjusted hospitalization risk by dialysate sodium (DNa) and predialysis serum sodium (SNa).

Cox model, as in Figure 4, but additionally adjusted for interdialytic weight gain (IDWG) and predialysis systolic blood pressure (SBP).

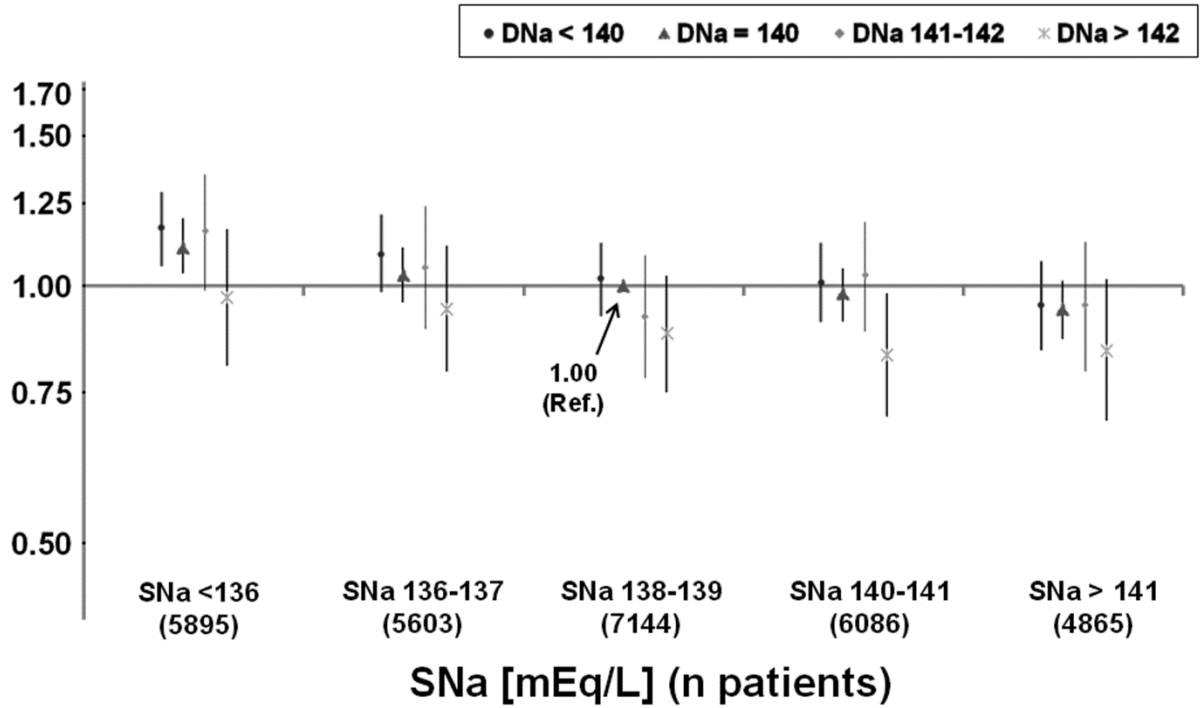
All-cause mortality Hazard Ratio (95% CI)
