The tissue at the edges of this image has some resemblance to early lymphocyte cell aggregates, but no cellularity is seen on further sections at different depths. **C**, Honeycomb with central blood vessels. **D**, Numerous, inter-digitating dendritiform cells. **E**, Clinical photograph of the subject shown in A, note numerous follicles.
