Markers are ¹⁴C-labelled Rainbow markers (Amersham), whose molecular weights are given in kilodaltons. B. Band retardation assay with the Z^+ *PGK* UAS subfragment as DNA binding site. Proteins used in binding reactions are named as in Figure 2.A. and are indicated below each corresponding lane. Lane marked 'Z⁺ corresponds to a binding reaction with no protein added and lane marked 'M' to a binding reaction with mock lysate. 'F' indicates unbound fragment and 'C' RAP1 specific complexes.
