



Figure S10. mir3c inhibits tumor growth in primary human breast xenografts MC1, UM2 and UM1

Cells isolated from primary xenografts MC1 (A) or UM2 (B) or UM1 (C) were transduced with the pTRIPZ-mir3c lentivirus in suspension. 10k pTRIPZ-MC1-mir3c or pTRIPZ-UM2-mir3c cells were injected into the 4th fatpads of NOD/SCID mice. The treatment started right after injection as indicated by the red arrow. DOX alone, docetaxel alone or the combination prevented tumor growth. * $p < 0.05$; Error bars represent mean \pm STDEV. The colored “*” on the side of the tumor growth curve represents the tumor growth is significantly different between Control group and the group with the same colored curve.
