The 2010 Poverty Guidelines for the 48 Contiguous States and the District of Columbia

The HHS provides a sliding-scale poverty cutoff based on the number of people per household. For the SIT Trial, participants indicated their income in \$10,000 increments. This data was then recoded into a dichotomous variable based on the cutoffs below.

Persons in family	Poverty guideline
1	\$10,830
2	14,570
3	18,310
4	22,050
5	25,790
6	29,530
7	33,270
8	37,010

For families with more than 8 persons, add \$3,740 for each additional person.
