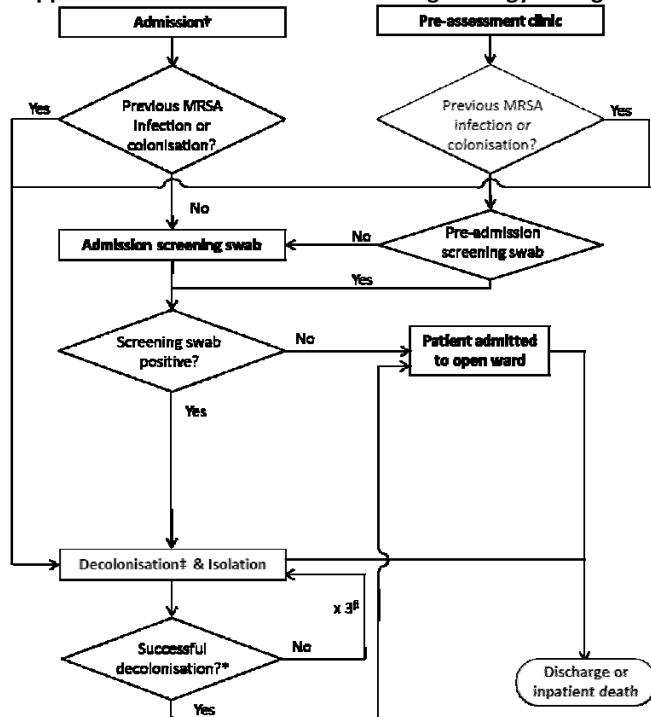


Supplemental file 2: Admission screening strategy during universal surveillance
