

Figure S5 Heterozygosity for *twins* rescues the rudimentary ovary phenotye of *gwl* mutants. **(A)** Percentage of wildtype control (Ctrl), gwl^{Sr18}/gwl^{180} , or $gwl^{Sr18}/tws^p gwl^{180}$ females carrying no, one, or two rudimentary ovaries. The number of analyzed females is shown inside the bars. Double asterisks indicate p<0.001. **(B)** Example of gwl^{Sr18}/gwl^{180} pair of ovaries, with a rudimentary ovary indicated by the arrow. **(C)** Example of a pair of ovaries in a $gwl^{Sr18}/tws^p gwl^{180}$ female. **(D)** Average number of eggs laid per female per day. Error bars represent standard deviations. Asterisks indicate p<0.05.
