

Table. Summary of the 44 relevant findings among 350 enrolled patients (12.6%). 11 of these 44 findings were known prior to presentation in the emergency department (ED). Only 5 of the remaining 33 patients had direct ophthalmoscopy performed by the ED physician, and all these direct ophthalmoscopic examinations were recorded as normal.
