Text S5 – Species whose positions in the phylogeny were not defined by Davis

14 species out of 89 were not positioned in [1].

The following species were placed according to [2]:

Columba oenas, Dendrocopos medius, Dryocopus martius, Galerida cristata, G. theklae, Locustella naevia, Lullula arborea, Luscinia luscinia, L. megarhynchos, Turdus viscivorus

The following species was placed according to [3]:

Emberiza hortulana

Three species have been placed as follows:

- Corvus cornix has been placed based on Corvus corone the position of which was given in [1];
- Oenanthe hispanica has been placed based on the position of Oenanthe oenanthe in [2];
- Picus vaillantii has been placed with P. canus and P. viridis.
