

Additional analyses Study 3

The percentage of men versus the percentage of woman that acted prosocial in the in the various conditions of Study 3:

Condition 1 (subtle respect): men (N=28) 50% vs women (N=22) 27% ($z=.1623$, $p=.103$ two-sided)

Condition 2 (moderate respect): men (N=33) 58% vs women (N=23) 74% ($z=1.255$, $p=.209$ two-sided)

Condition 3 (intense respect): men (N=40) 80% vs women (N=21) 86% ($z=.551$, $p=.581$ two-sided)

The percentage of observations that acted prosocial in the various conditions of Study 3, comparison of the observations, where confederate and participant differed vs not differed in gender:

Condition 1 (subtle respect): no-gender difference (N=24) 25% vs gender difference (N=26) 54% ($z=.2080$, $p=.002$ one-sided)

Condition 2 (moderate respect): no-gender difference (N=27) 70% vs gender difference (N=29) 59% ($z=.917$, $p=.180$ one-sided)

Condition 3 (intense respect): no-gender difference (N=26) 77% vs gender difference (N=35) 86% ($z=.883$, $p=.189$ one-sided)
