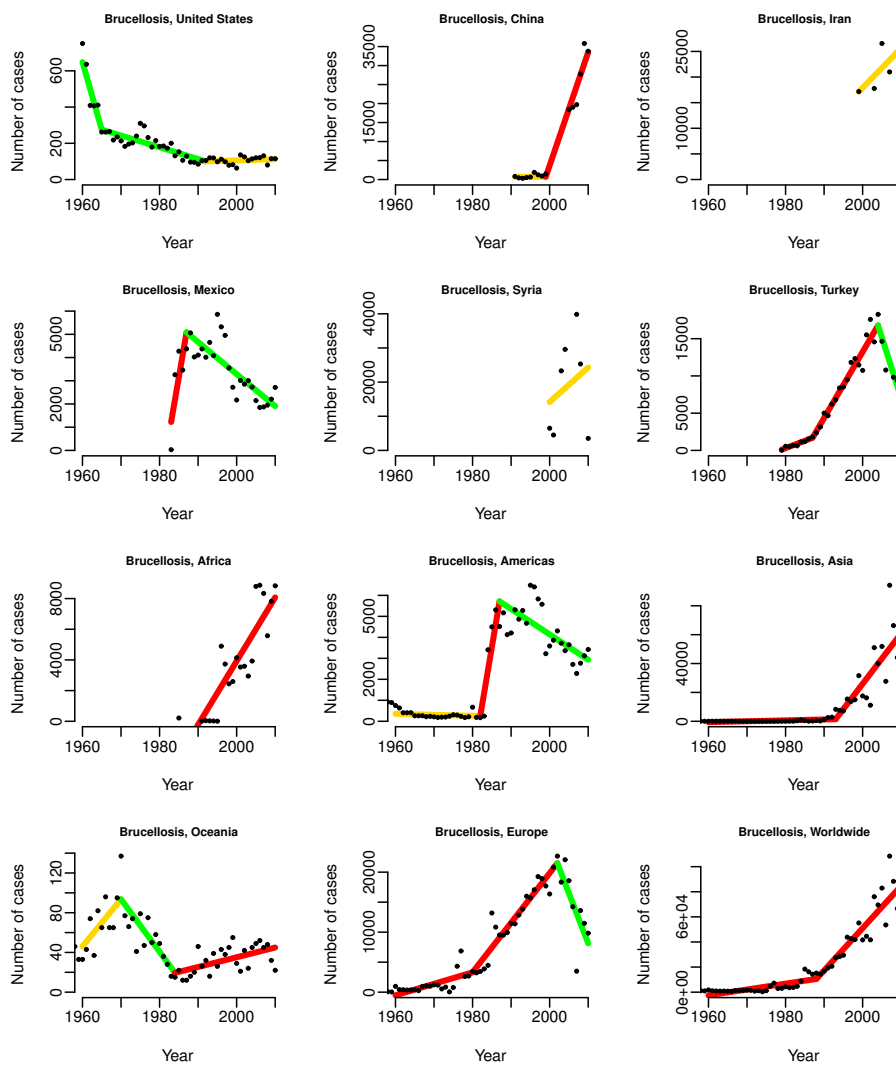
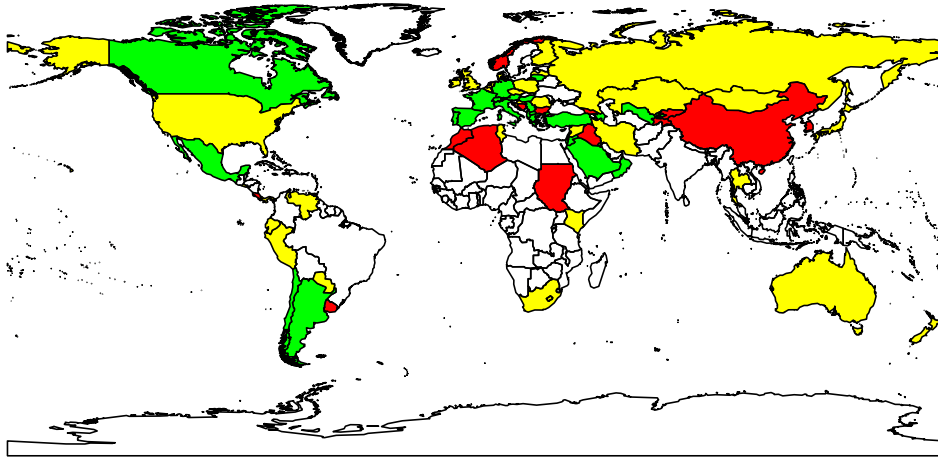


Figure S1: Brucellosis

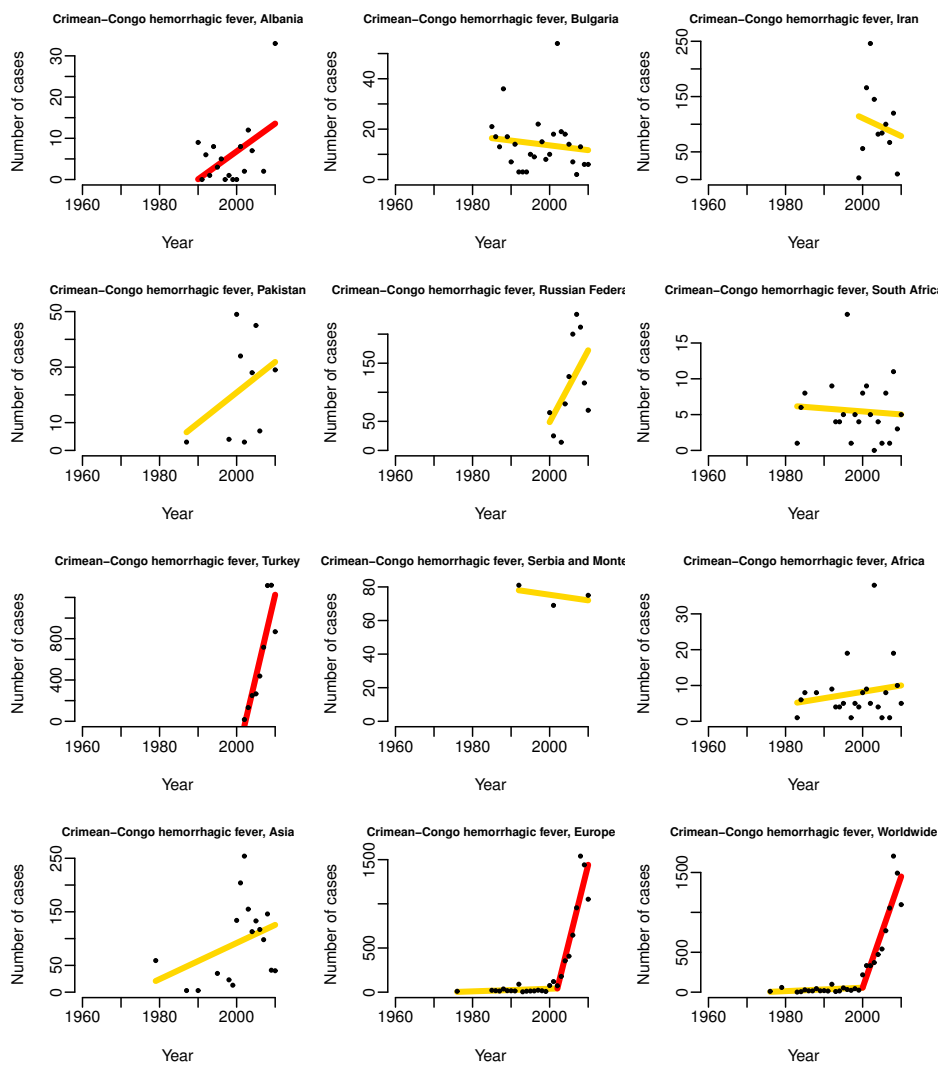
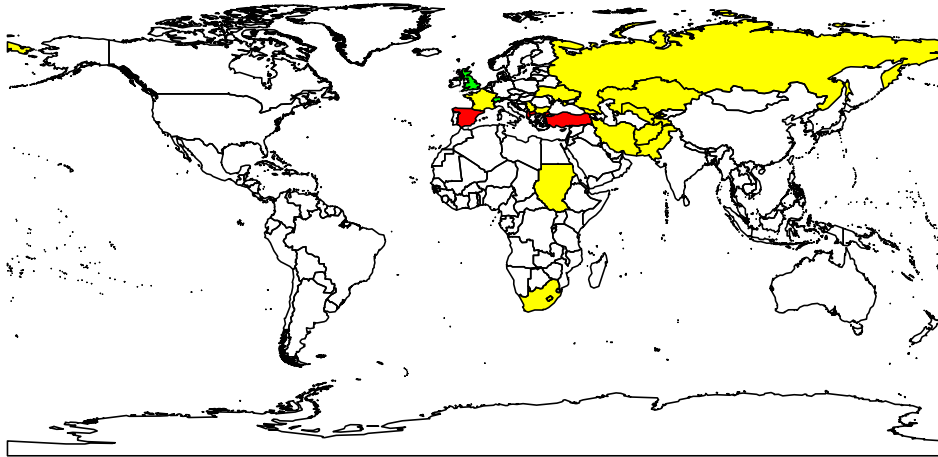


Figure S2: Crimean-Congo hemorrhagic fever

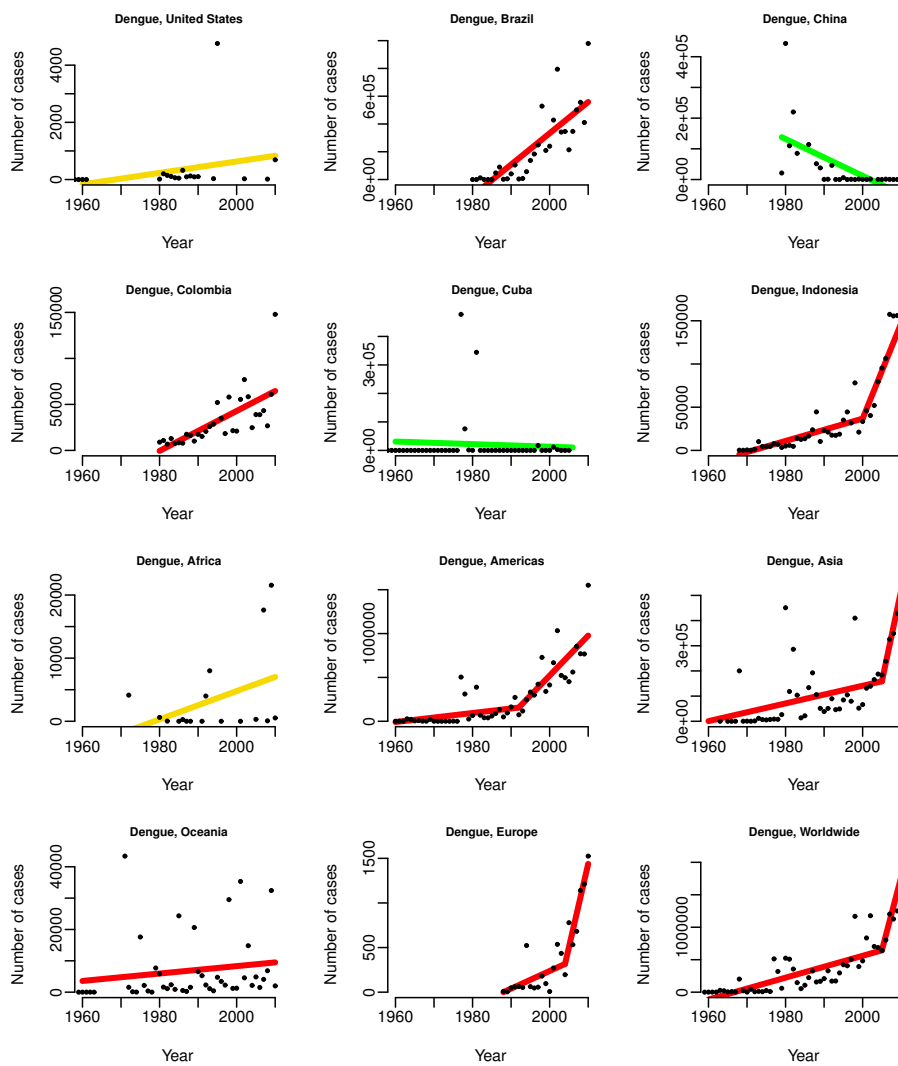
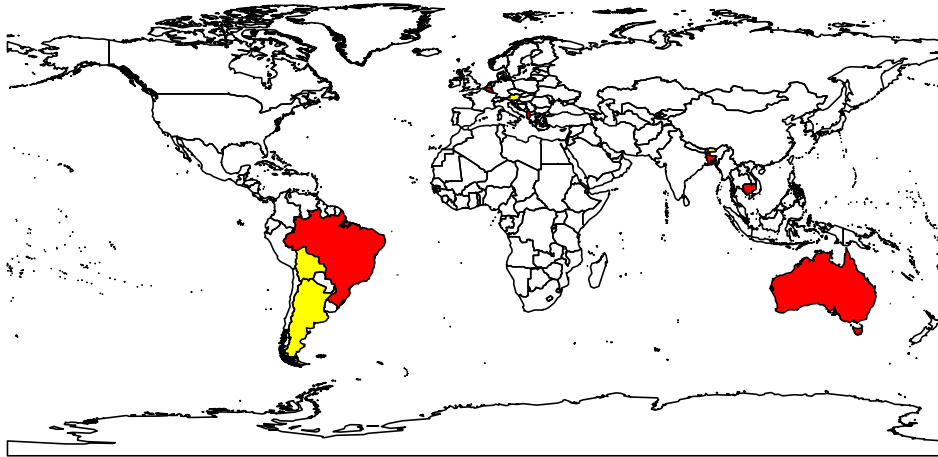


Figure S3: Dengue

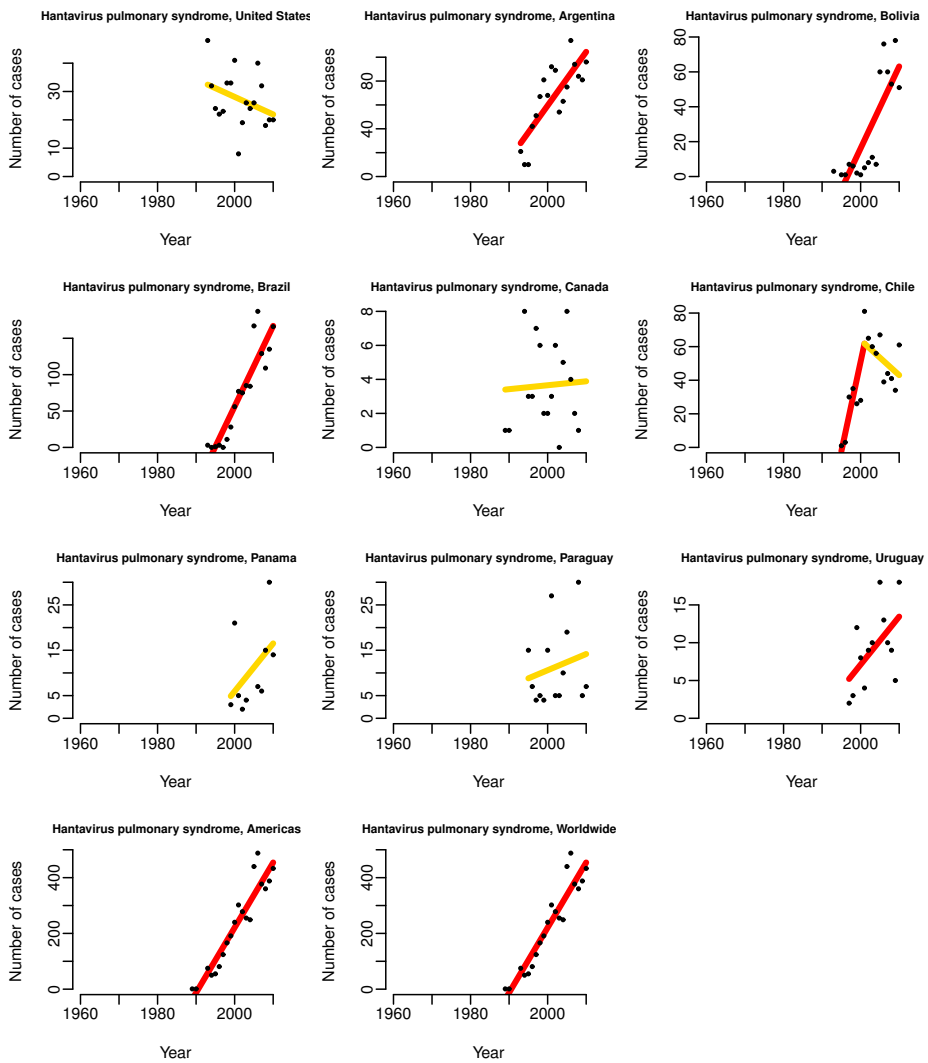
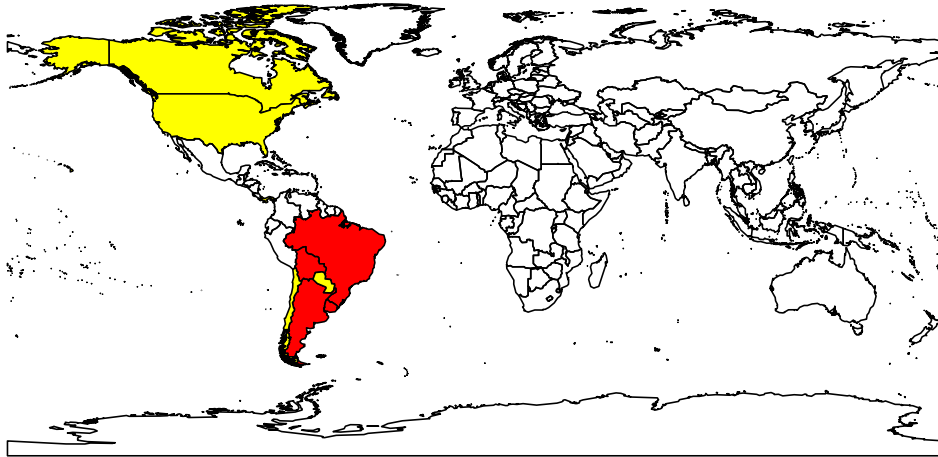


Figure S4: Hantavirus pulmonary syndrome

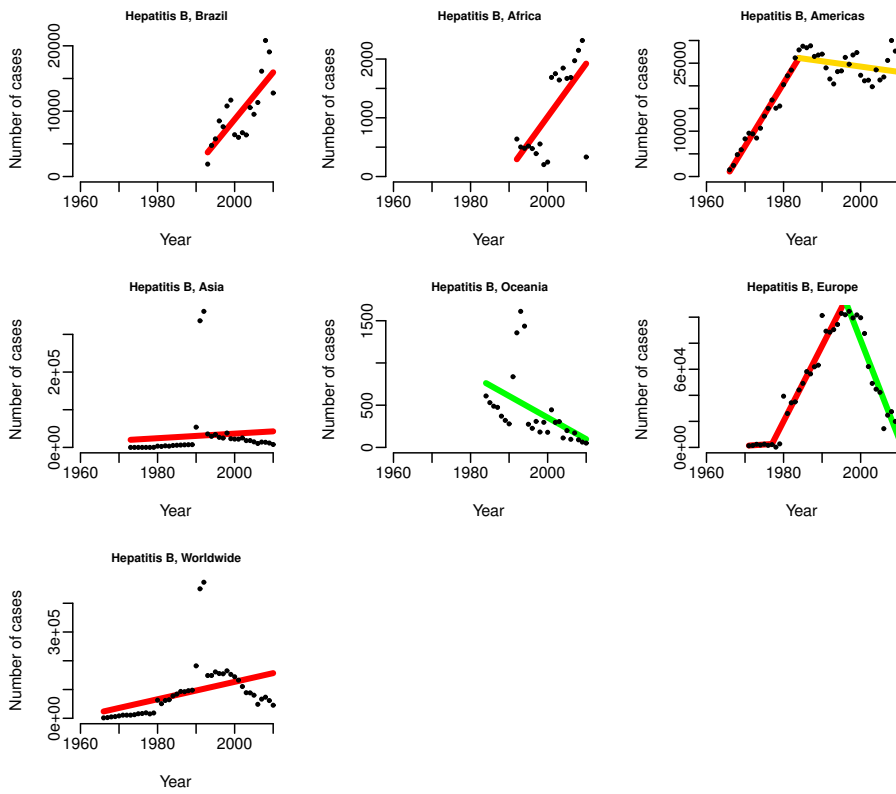
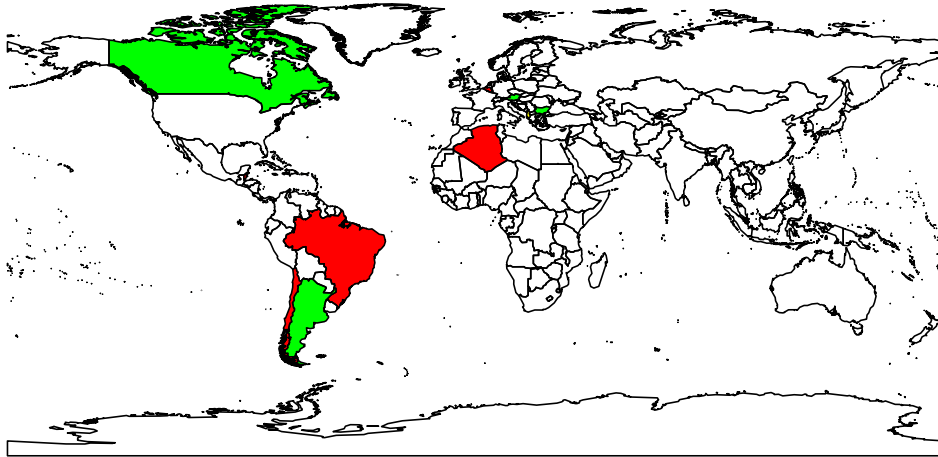


Figure S5: Hepatitis B

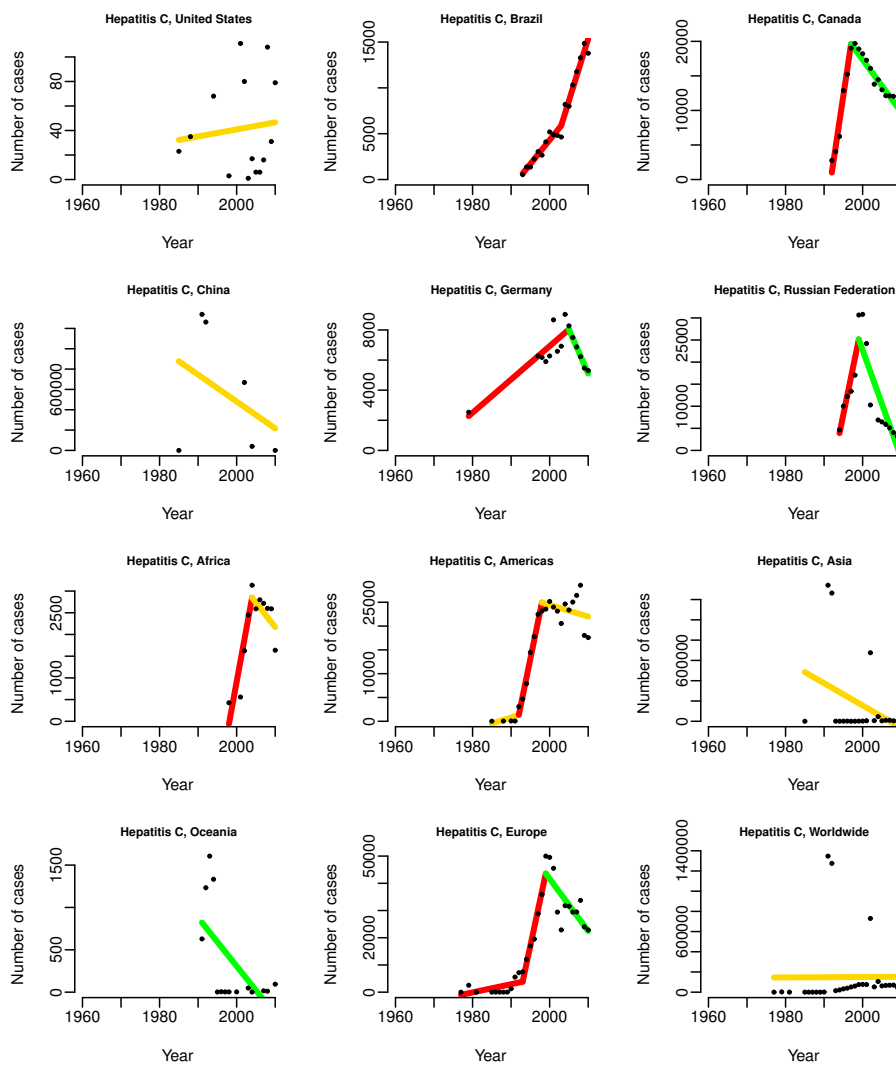
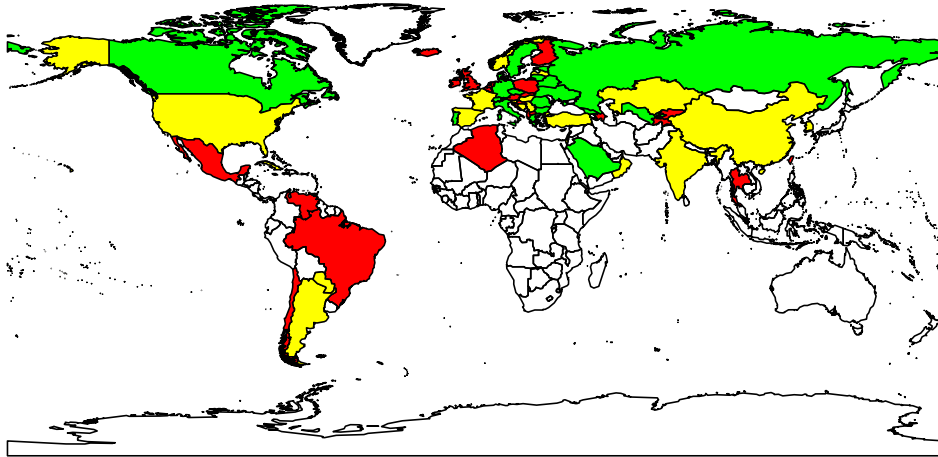


Figure S6: Hepatitis C

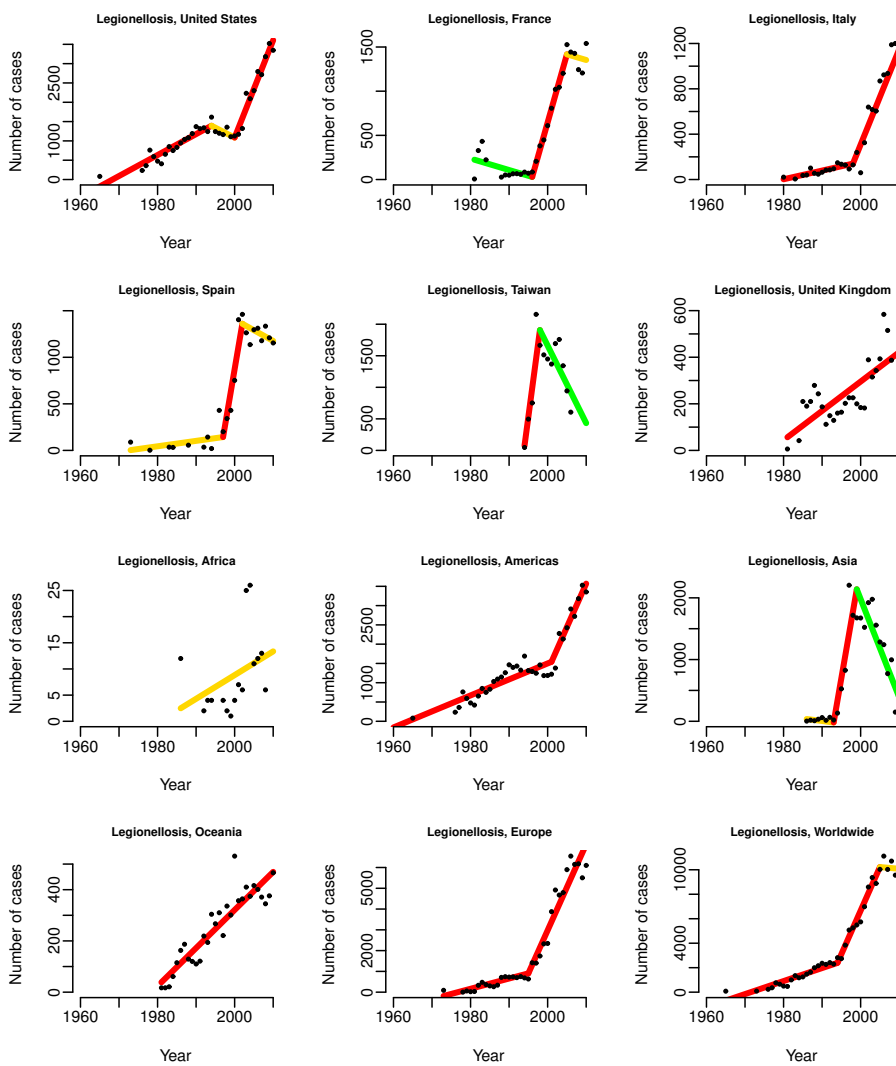
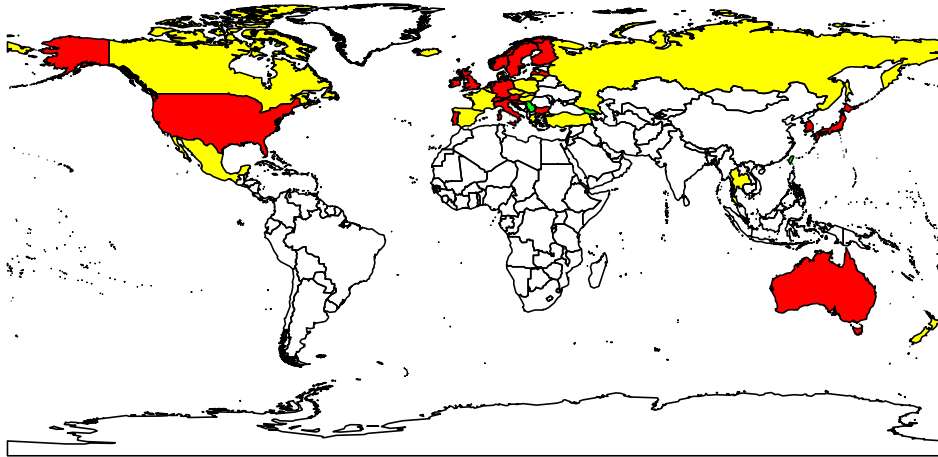


Figure S7: Legionellosis

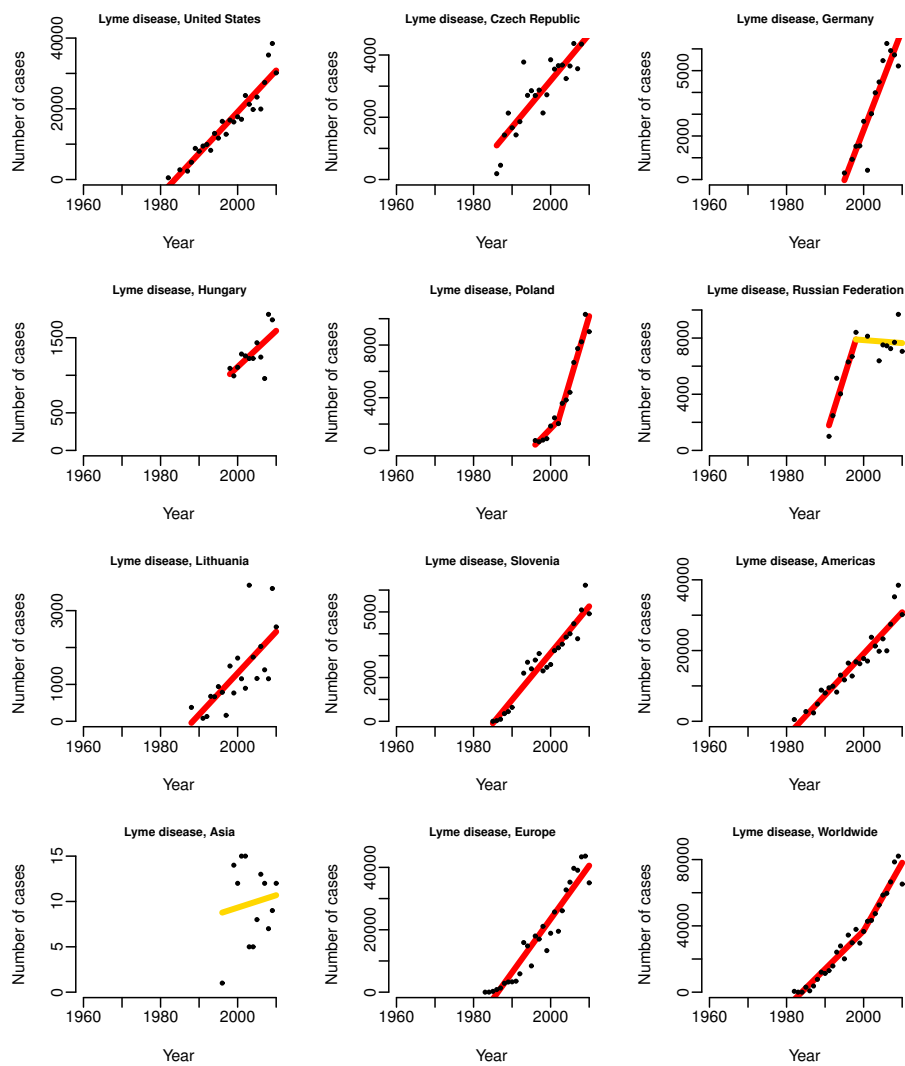
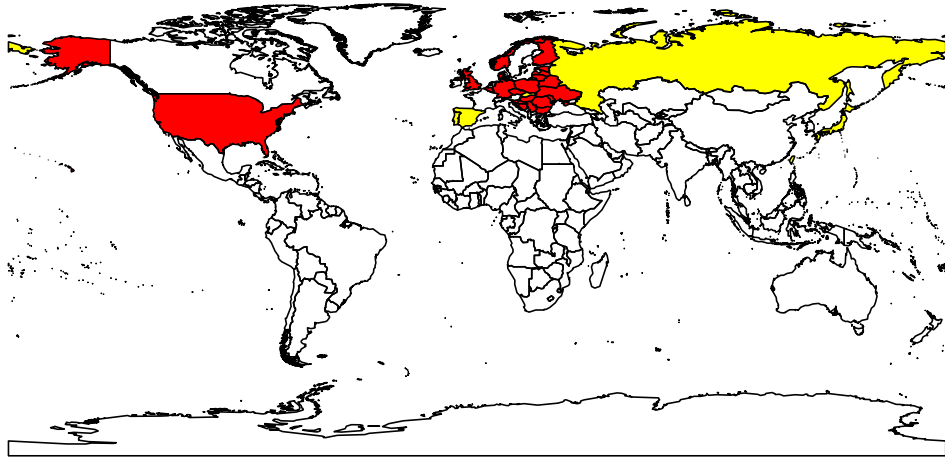


Figure S8: Lyme disease

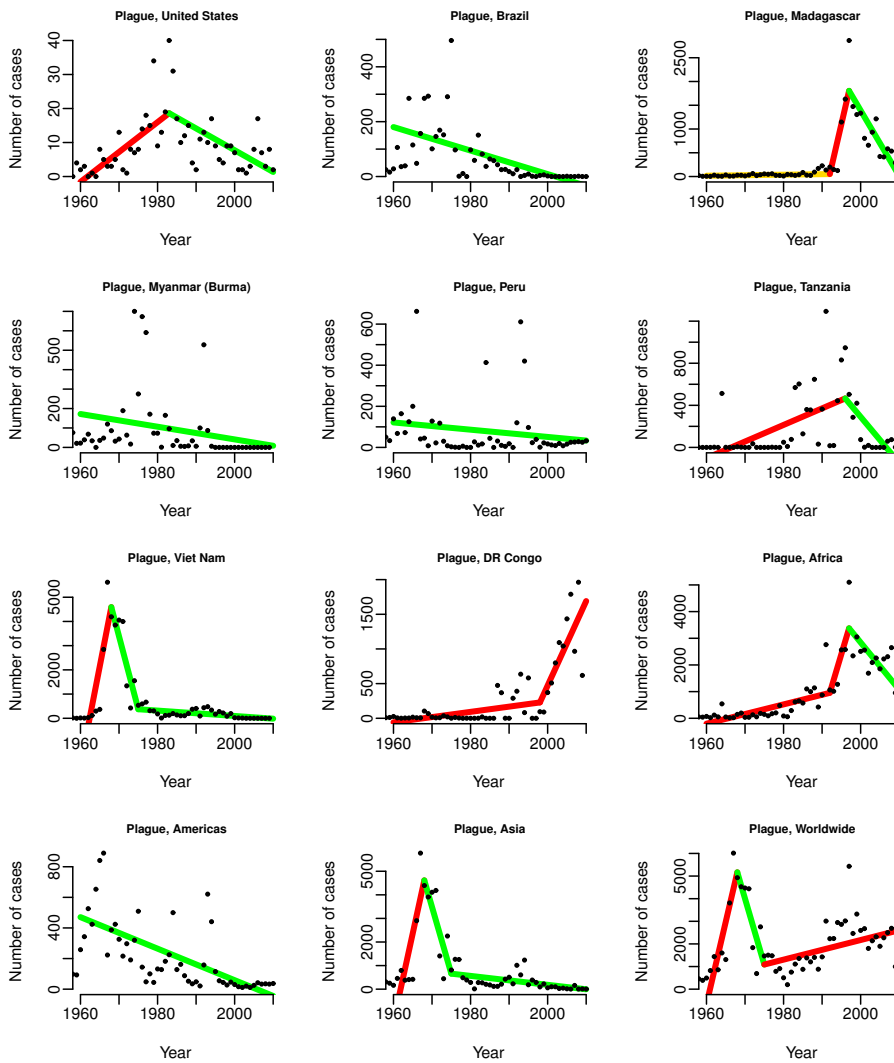
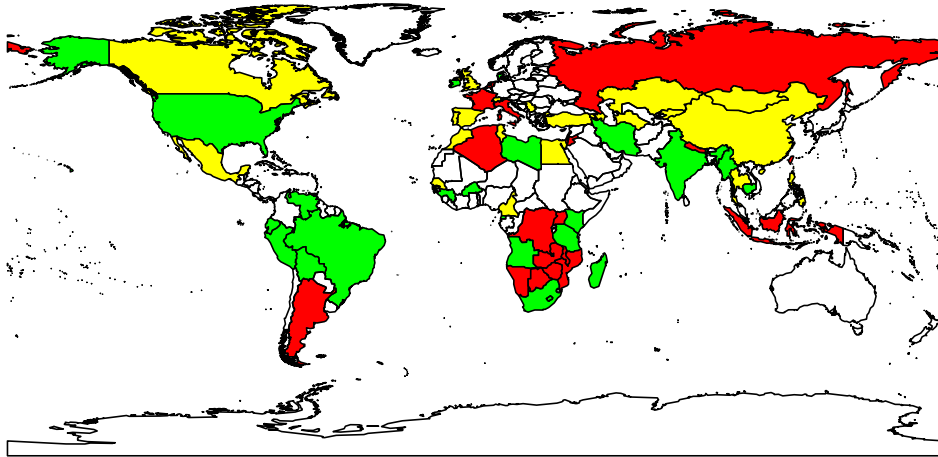


Figure S9: Plague

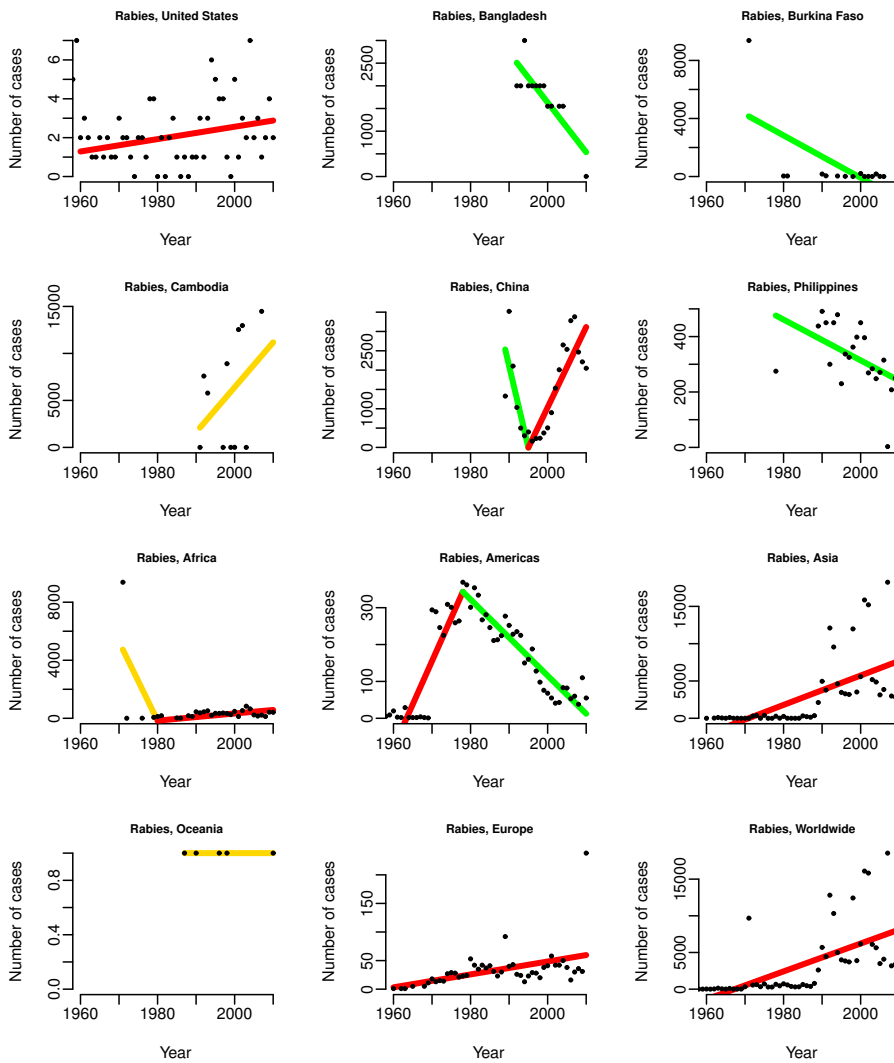
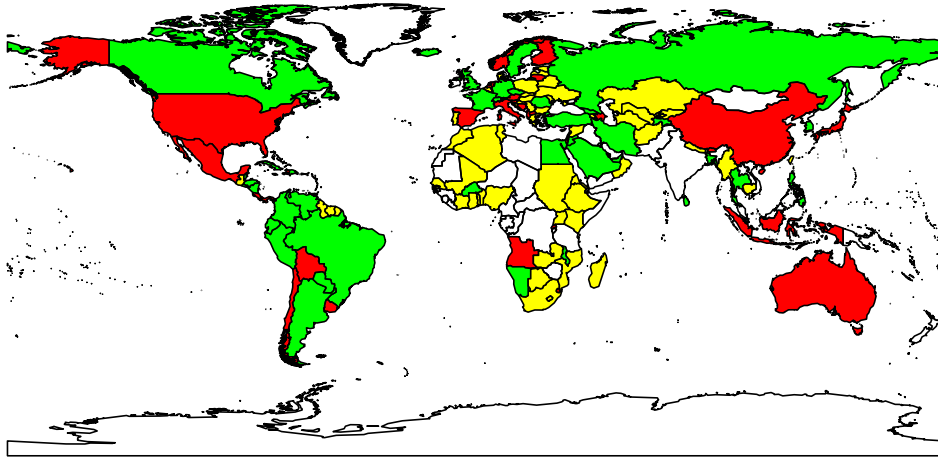


Figure S10: Rabies

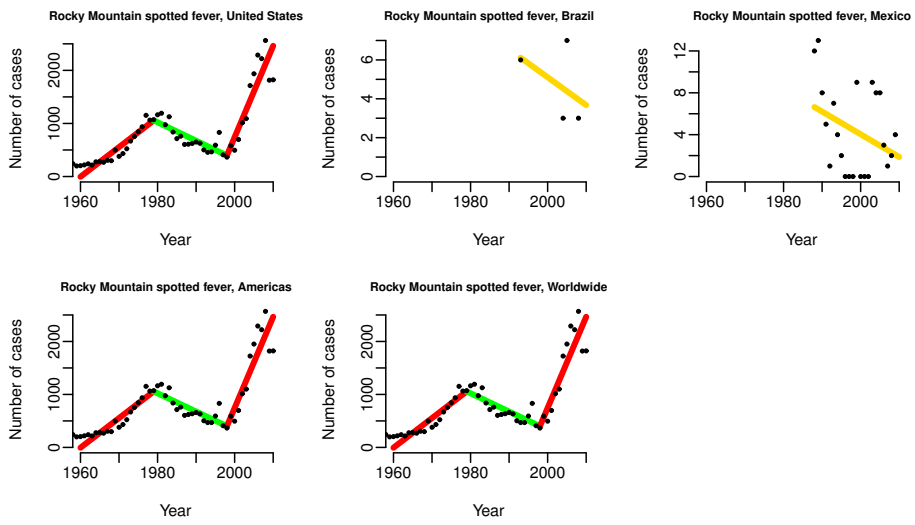
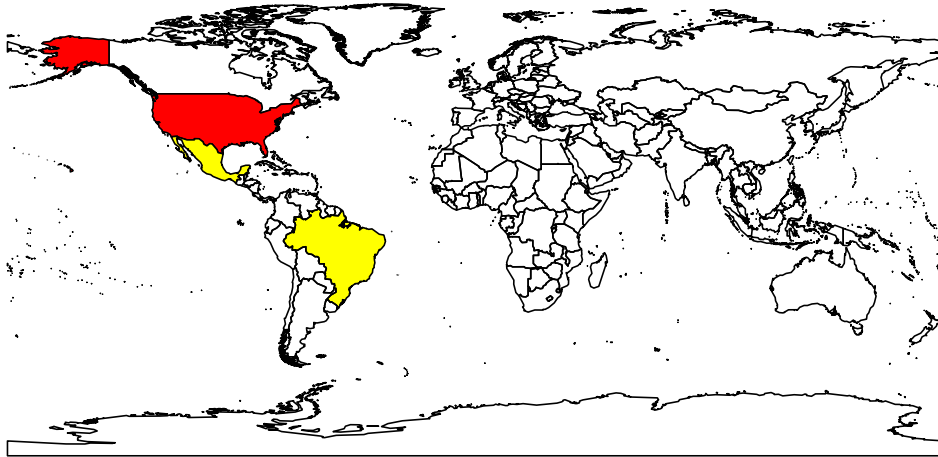


Figure S11: Rocky Mountain spotted fever

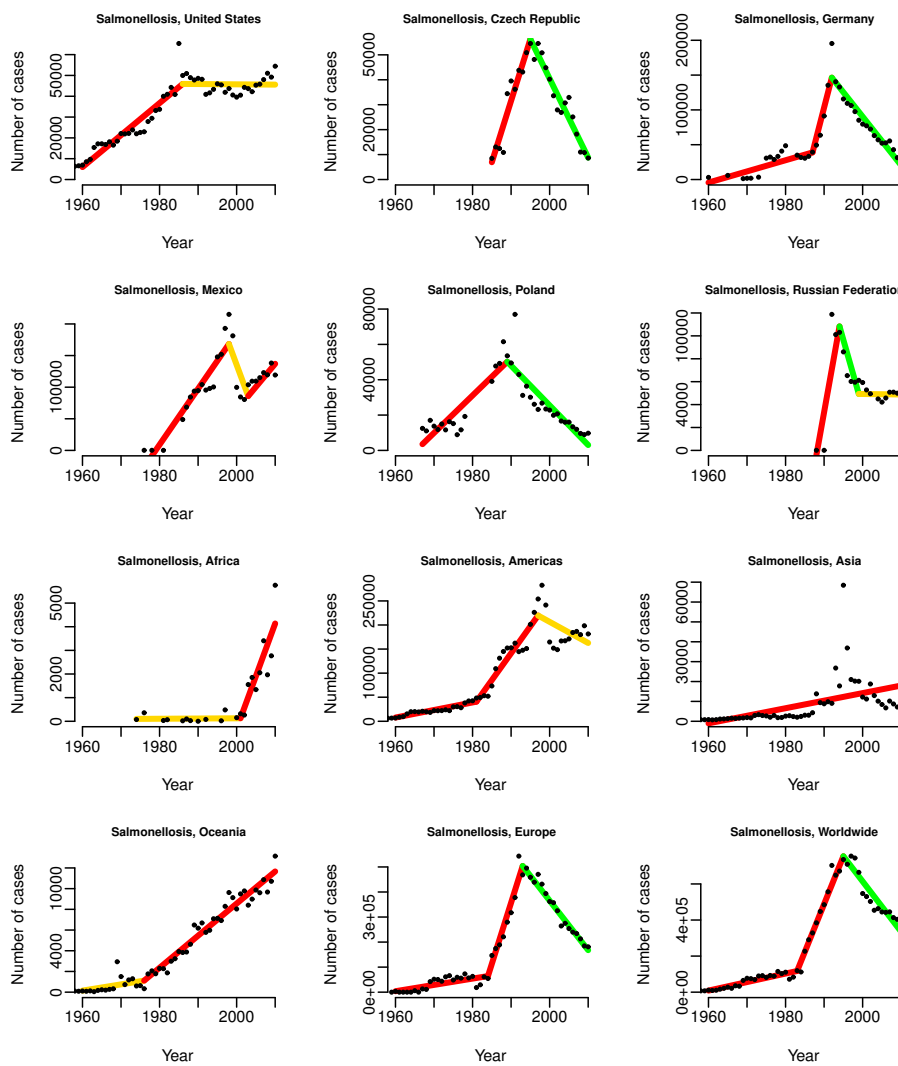
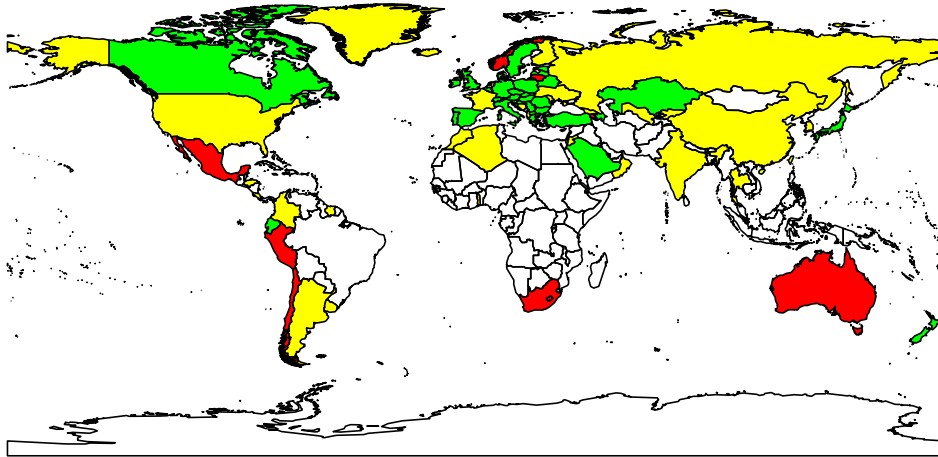


Figure S12: Salmonellosis
