

Appendix 4 (as supplied by the authors): The cross-tabulation of physician’s guess of allocation and actual allocation for all patients with data for both (1 patient from the per-protocol set was missing data for the physician’s guess)

An application of McNemar’s test yielded a *p* value of 0.04, indicating a significant association between actual allocation and the physician’s ability to guess allocation.
