Dots represent statistical significance ($P<0.05$). Stars at the bottom of each graph represent significant point-wise interactions ($P<0.05$) between two subgroups in multiplicative (left panels) and additive (right panels) scale. No stars indicate no significant point-wise interaction. Adjustments were for age, sex, race, smoking, history of cardiovascular disease, systolic blood pressure, diabetes, total cholesterol concentration, body mass index, and eGFR splines.
