

FIG S1 Schematic overview of the porcine stomach.

The stomach was divided into 3 main regions: the cardiac gland (C), fundus gland (F) and pyloric gland (P) region. These regions were further divided into 2 subregions (A, B), which were collected separately for histology and bacterial re-isolation. The scheme was modified from Koga et al. (1).
