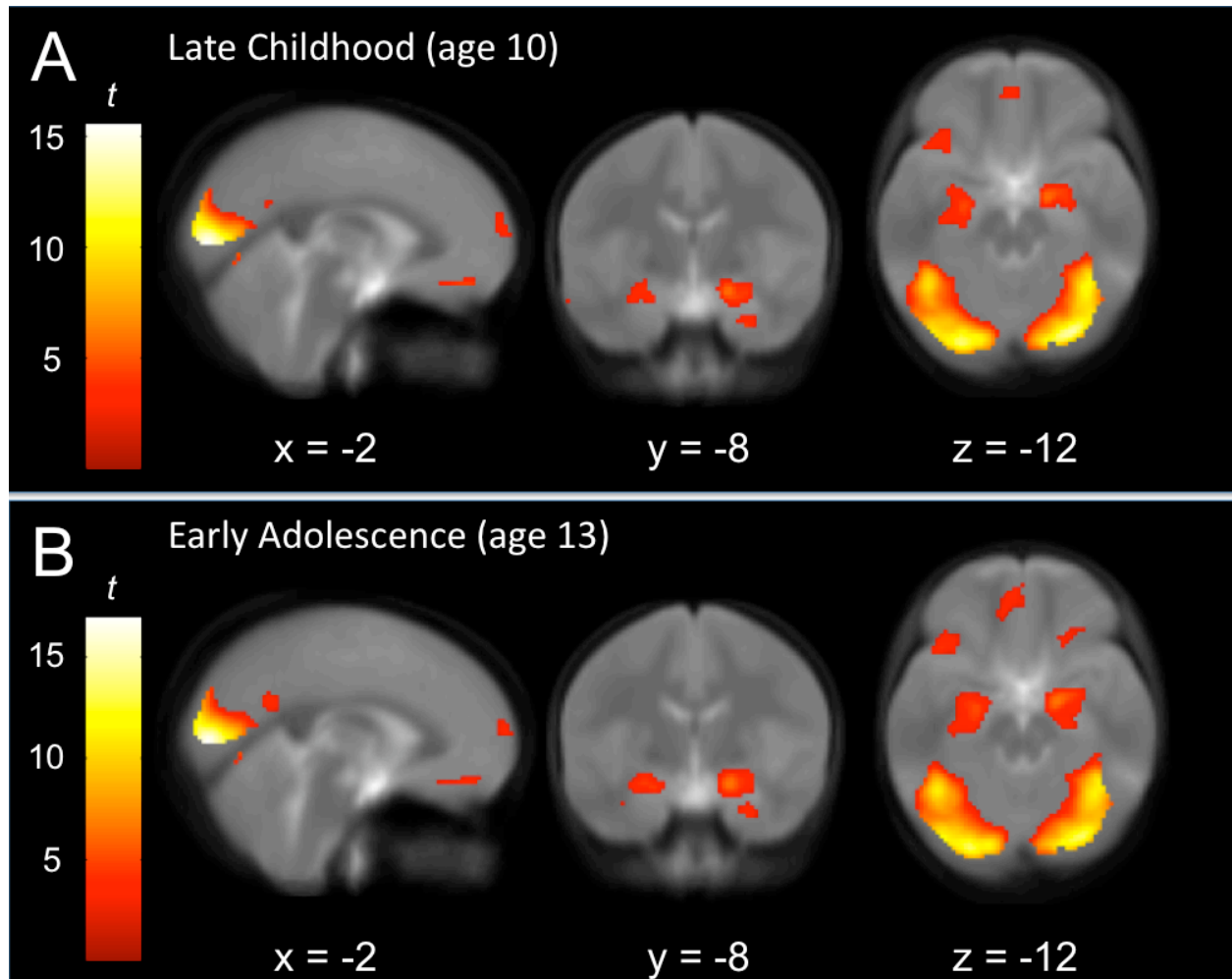

Neural responses to facial expressions of emotion in late childhood and early adolescence.



Panels A and B depict BOLD signal during observation of emotional expressions during late childhood and early adolescence, respectively. Results are displayed on the average coplanar high-resolution scan across both timepoints for all children. x, y, and z refer to the Talairach coordinates corresponding to the left-right, anterior-posterior, and inferior-superior axes, respectively.
