We would like to invite you to take part in the Welsh study of mothers and babies. Before you decide, you need to understand why we are carrying out this research and what it would involve for you. Please take time to read this information sheet carefully.

If you would like more information about the study then ask your midwife. If you decide you do not want to take part, it will not affect the care that you receive during your pregnancy. Please take your time to decide if you would like to take part in the study. You can stop taking part in the study at any time, even if you have agreed to take part.

What is the purpose of the study?

The purpose of this study is to investigate whether certain findings that are sometimes seen on ultrasound scans done between 18 and 20 weeks of pregnancy can tell us anything about the health of your baby. These findings are often known as ‘markers’. As ultrasound images have improved, more of the ultrasound markers have been found. However, we do not know if these markers are important for your baby’s health. So we need to collect this information and investigate if there are any connections with long-term health and development of the baby.

Why have I been invited?

We are asking all women in Wales who have decided to have an ultrasound scan at 18 to 20 weeks to take part in the study.



Do I have to take part?

It is entirely up to you if you would like to take part in the study. You do not have to take part in the study and you will be able to withdraw at any time without giving a reason. This would not affect the standard of care you receive.

What will happen to me if I take part?

- We will ask you to fill in a short questionnaire.
- If you agree to take part, the person doing the ultrasound scan will record on the computer screen whether or not they have seen any markers. They will send the information to the study centre.
- The person doing the scan will tell you if they have seen any problems that are normally reported at the time.
- They will not tell you about ultrasound markers that are not normally reported because we don't yet know what they mean.
- The research team will use your NHS number to link your scan records with results from other tests you might have during pregnancy.
- The research team will use your baby's NHS number to collect information about the health of your baby and to get the results of your baby's blood-spot test.
- The study team will write to you after the birth to check on the health of your baby.
- If you would like to take part in this study, we will ask you to sign a consent form.

What will I have to do?

Come for your ultrasound scan appointment as arranged with you by the Ultrasound Department. The Antenatal Screening Wales leaflet, '*Ultrasound scans in pregnancy*' gives you more information about the scan.

Will my private and medical details be kept safe?

All information the team collect about you during the study will be kept confidential. All information will be held securely on hospital computers and by the study centre.

What will happen to the results of the research study?

The research team will publish the findings from this study in a scientific journal. They will not include your name and personal details in any reports or publications.

Who is organising and funding the research?

Antenatal Screening Wales is working closely with Cardiff University to carry out this research. It is being funded by the Welsh Assembly Government /Medical Research Council Health Research Award Partnership.
